SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent announced that yesterday, SAUSD held the first set of School Safety and Wellness Community Town Hall meetings. He thanked all the community members who attended, the community partners who were able to provide valuable information and resources, and Santa Ana Police Chief David Valentin and his team, for answering questions on many important issues. He also thanked the SAUSD staff who worked hard to set up and organize these meetings, and to our Board of Education members who participated. Through an online form, and through community members who attended, we received well over 100 questions, which have been answered, or are working to getting answers through various district departments. He announced that the next pair of meetings will be July 18, at 9:00 a.m., then again at 6:00 p.m. and that we are building an online repository where the most common questions and themes will be posted, along with responses so community members can have a reference to review and find answers. Additionally, videos of these town hall meetings are on the district website.

Mr. Almendarez reminded the community that through the summer, SAUSD will be offering free daily testing between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. at four sites: Santa Ana High School, Mendez Fundamental Intermediate, Santa Ana Valley High School, and here at the District office. He shared that the FDA recently authorized Moderna and the Pfizer-Biontech COVID-19 vaccinations for children from 6 months old to age four. Anyone five years and older are already authorized to receive these vaccinations. SAUSD continues to encourage that all children and adults who are eligible receive the appropriate vaccinations. This will help us ensure we return for the upcoming school year healthy and safe. He invited everyone to visit the district website or to follow us on social media for more information on COVID testing, as well as other resources.

Lastly, he congratulated Santa Ana High School's Speech and Debate team for winning the National School of Excellence Award during the recent National Speech and Debate Tournament in Louisville, Kentucky. Santa Ana High beat out teams from across the country for this honor. Additionally, teams from other schools from our district took home high honors. This prestigious tournament again proved that Santa Ana Unified School District is a national powerhouse in Speech and Debate. He thanked program specialist Sal Tinajero and his dedicated team for all the work they do to support our Speech and Debate students.

BOARD REPORTS

Mrs. Amezcua requested more information regarding computer technicians in the B2B. Some are 9.5 month positions with 7.5 hours. She would like to know how many there are and if the job description fits what they are doing. She clarified that the COVID pay for employees during summer school was taken care of today. Mrs. Amezcua thanked the nutrition services staff. She addressed the community town hall meetings and thanked the parents that came out. She added that it is important to publicize the meetings and suggested putting it out on the Register, Stay Connected, flyers in laundromats, apartment complexes, and child care is provided. Mrs. Amezcua addressed the reports on school shootings everywhere and encouraged everyone to come out to ask for safety. She thanked staff at Taft for the fire drill and to look into the needs for schools. She thanked Superintendent and shared that the next meeting will be live on YouTube and Facebook. Thanked everyone who supported. She asked that a flyer go out with the students from Engage 360. The next town hall meeting will be on Monday, July 18 at 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Mr. Palacio asked Superintendent when the posting of the town hall meetings will be done. He asked for an update on the Kennedy Special Education issues that he has been waiting on for the past year. He addressed the COVID 19

pay for employees in Nutrition Services and Special Education. He asked for follow up to ensure employees are given their benefit. Mr. Palacio wished everyone a nice summer.

Dr. Alvarez thanked the public speakers. He encouraged everyone to attend the school safety and wellness town hall meetings Monday, July 18 at 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. and asked how are we involving our youth in the process. Lastly, he congratulated the Speech and Debate Team that competed in Kentucky. He shared that Santa Ana High School was named the National School of Excellence in Speech and Debate and hopes to recognize them at a future Board meeting.

Ms. Torres requested a B2B update on Adult Transition Program (ATP) and where we are at with the placement of students at Santa Ana College. She also stated that ATP could use supplies. She thanked the SAUSD representatives for attending the PRIDE event. She shared that there was also a Juneteenth event but there was no district collaboration and hopes there can be next year. Ms. Torres announced the joint meeting with the City of Santa Ana on July 11, 2022 which will be a Zoom meeting and will be televised. She reminded HR and Payroll departments that as we close out the year, to make sure we are ready for 2022-23 school year in terms of hiring, placement, temp. vs. probationary vs. permanent, and payments. Ms. Torres thanked public speakers for their comments and lastly, she congratulated Johnny on his new position.


Dr. Rodriguez acknowledged the LCAP presentation as being very strong but it is still a lot of work. He congratulated the Speech and Debate team especially Santa Ana High School and the team led by Mr. Tinajero. He asked staff to follow up with individual from ATP. Dr. Rodriguez congratulated staff that have made the summer go. He also announced that there are a number of shows at Segerstrom High School and Santa Ana High School. There is also the Saturday Night Lights event July 8, 2022 at El Salvador Park. Lastly he addressed Ms. Lucy Solorzano with respect to the online forum. He asked Superintendent that we ensure there is a two way communication for the live town hall meetings.



WHEREAS, the Governmental Standards Accounting Board (GASB) has issued Statement No. 54, establishing a hierarchy clarifying constraints that govern how a government entity can use amounts reported as fund balance; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education (Board) has previously adopted Board Policy 3100 acknowledging its authority to commit, assign, or evaluate existing fund-balance classifications and identify the intended uses of committed or assigned funds; and

WHEREAS, the committed fund balance classification reflects amounts subject to specific internal constraints self-imposed by the Board; and

WHEREAS, once the committed fund-balance constraints are imposed, it requires the constraint to be revised, removed or redirected for other purposes by the Board in the same manner as the Board originally approved the commitment; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined it has specific needs that it elects to fund with portions of its General Fund ending fund balance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education, hereby commits to utilizing portions of its general fund ending balance, as indicated by the committed fund classification in its financial statements, for the following purposes:




