Board President Torres called the meeting to order at 5:13 p.m.

BOARD REPORTS

Dr. Rodriguez thanked everyone for the start of this school year including the wonderful work of leadership, teachers, and classified staff. He also thanked administrators for their strong leadership in preparing for tropical storm Hilary, as well as the Facilities department staff who worked night and day.

Ms. Katelyn Brazer Aceves thanked her colleagues for nominating her to the Council of the Great City Schools. She expressed her gratitude for the workforce agreement. Ms. Brazer Aceves highlighted & acknowledged the strong community partnerships & contracts such as the agreement with Chiac, Project Kinship, and Neutral Ground, and others listed on the consent calendar. She requested a mini presentation on the The SEVA Collective Food Distribution.

Mr. Bustos thanked the team for the weekend work in preparation for the storm. He shared that he received family concerns on school opening on Monday but because of the preparation, communication, and trust in the team he felt it was safe opening schools. Mr. Bustos addressed the increase in COVID cases and requested for information to be sent out to the community on staying home if they are not feeling well and masking. He welcomed new classified and certificated employees. He was happy to announce that he is half way in reaching his promise of visiting all school sites in his first year of his term as a Board member. Mr. Bustos highlighted a win for San Francisco's Proposition N, which allows non-citizen parents, legal guardians, or caregivers for children ages 18 or younger, in the San Francisco Unified School District to vote in elections for the Board of Education, regardless of whether they are U.S. Citizens, noting that when our community is involved in decision making we have better outcomes in students academically and in wellness.


Dr. Alvarez concurred with Dr. Rodriguez regarding the start of the school year despite the threat of Hurricane Hilary, sharing that it is a testament to all of our dedication to the safety of the community. He gave a shout out to Mr. Williams, our SAUSD family, and community.

Ms. Torres addressed her colleagues' comments on COVID reminders and the passing of the attendance resolution, adding that attendance is important but in a safe way. It is important that students do not feel pressured to go to school if they are not feeling well. She acknowledged Ms. Brazer Aceves' request for information on The Seva Collective and asked that it be presented as a B2B. Ms. Torres requested a summary by legal counsel on the San Francisco policy on School Board Elections. She commented on having empathy for young people who are homeless but also for adults and added that there is rhetoric out there, but we should not participate in dehumanizing language. Ms. Torres shared that she attended the Fremont Mural Unveiling event and acknowledged the public speaker's comments related to the conflict that took place there. She asked the Superintendent for verification on whether or not there was knowledge of the concern ahead of time, and for a process for community events to be able to manage these type of situations. She shared that the unveiling itself was nice and thought the mural was wonderful, adding that murals are culturally significant and should increase them in our District. Ms. Torres welcomed everyone new to our District and encouraged them all to take care of themselves as the first two years are rough. Lastly, she echoed Board members' comments on the process that took place during the weekend in preparation for the hurricane with Executive Cabinet leading the way with all hands on deck. It was a huge endeavor and she thanked everyone for their leadership. Ms. Torres wished everyone a happy first week of school.

Having no further business to come before the Board, President Torres adjourned the meeting at 8:35 p.m.



Nonetheless, "Chicano" and "Chicana" was reclaimed by ethnic Mexicans in the 1960s and 1970s and with the inclusion of "Chicanx" in the past decade as a more inclusive gender-neutral term to express political empowerment, ethnic solidarity, and pride in being of Indigenous descent; and

WHEREAS, the Chicano Movement was a social and political movement in the United States inspired by prior acts of resistance among people of Mexican descent, that worked to embrace a Chicano/Chicana/Chicanx identity and worldview that combated structural racism, encouraged cultural revitalization, and achieved community empowerment by rejecting assimilation. Examples of this movement are shown through the advocacy work of individuals like Vickie Castro, Ruben Salazar, Corky Gonzales, Sylvia Mendez, Dolores Huerta, and countless others; and

WHEREAS, Chicanos have contributed toward significant technological and scientific advancements in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Chicano Movement was influenced by the Black Power movement, and both movements held similar objectives of community empowerment and liberation, while also calling for Black-Brown unity; and

WHEREAS, prominent Chicano leaders spearheaded the fight for labor rights and education reform, and

30 WHEREAS, in 1946, the Supreme Court issued another landmark ruling in Mendez
31 v. Westminster School District of Orange County that declared school segregation
32 of Mexican Americans illegal, and

33 WHEREAS, according to the 2019 American Community Survey, people from Mexico
34 comprised 11.3 percent of the foreign-born population in the United States.
35 Chicanos/Chicanas/Chicanxs people have been a long-standing part of the culture of
36 the United States, with an undeniable influence in education, public safety,
37 infrastructure, economic development, culinary arts and governance; and

38 WHEREAS, Ruben Salazar, a significant civil rights advocate, was the first
39 Mexican-American columnist for the Los Angeles Times, and first journalist to shed

42 facilitated the East Los Angeles Walkouts, which advocated for the teaching of
43 Mexican-American heritage in schools, by highlighting the racial inequalities in

45 WHEREAS, Chicanos/Chicanas/Chicanx people represent a significant and
46 rapidly growing demographic in Santa Ana, and we honor their invaluable
47 accomplishments and contributions.

CATEGORY: Personnel

RESPONSIBLE OFFICE(S): Human Resources

SCOPE:

The Board recognizes its primary responsibility is to comply with applicable State and federal laws.

POLICY:

The Governing Board desires to maximize staff and community confidence in district hiring, promotion, and other employment decisions by promoting practices that are free of conflicts of interest or the appearance of impropriety. (cf. 4030 – Nondiscrimination in Employment) (cf. 9270 – Conflict of Interest)

The Board prohibits the appointment of any person to a position for which his/her relative maintains management, supervisory, evaluation, or promotion responsibilities and prohibits an employee from participating in any decision that singularly applies to any of his/her relatives. (cf. 4111.4211.4311 – Recruitment and Selection) (cf. 4115 – Evaluation/Supervision) (cf. 4215 – Evaluation/Supervision) (cf. 4315 – Evaluation/Supervision).

This prohibition shall be held in abeyance for the 2023-2024 school year with respect to the appointment of substitute employees to positions that are deemed hard to fill by Human Resources. Any relative of the substitute employee shall be prohibited from maintaining direct management, supervisory, evaluation, or promotion responsibilities, and from participating in any decision that singularly applies to the substitute employee. The appointment of such substitute employees shall be approved by Human Resources.

For purposes of this policy, relative means blood or affinity within the third degree, which includes the individual's spouse, domestic partner, parents, grandparents, great-grandparents, children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, brothers, sisters, aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, and the similar family of the individual's spouse or domestic partner.

In addition, the Superintendent or designee may determine, on a case-by-case basis, whether to appoint or reassign a person to a position in the same department or facility as an employee with whom he/she maintains a personal relationship when that relationship has the potential of create (1) an adverse impact on supervision, safety, security, or morale of other district employees or (2) a conflict of interest for the individuals involved which is greater because of their relationship than it would be for another person.

An employee shall notify his/her supervisor within 30 days of any change in his/her circumstances that may constitute a violation of this policy.
