In closed session, the Board approved the terms of a separation agreement entered into with a certificated employee that includes tendering and acceptance of letter of resignation from employment with a deferred effective date, continuation of compensation pursuant to contract, release of any and all claims, and release of District from compensation terms should alternative employment be secured.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Almendarez thanked the staff, parents, community, and students for their support and patience during the first week and a half of school. He informed the public that the District was able to provide devices and hotspots and is aware of the spottiness of those devices. He assured the public that staff is working very hard to address those issues. He shared that Orange County was removed from the Governor's watch list which allows some of our surrounding districts with low rates to begin the countdown. Unfortunately the city of Santa Ana does not fall under that category. We need to be below the 8% threshold across the District in order to move in that direction. Superintendent announced that the District is continuing its work with Latino Health Access and is going to reach out to the City of Santa Ana hoping to partner up with their CARES initiative. He also stated that we are receiving a lot of calls with concerns regarding the athletics program. On July 20, 2020, CIF released a memo stating that the Fall, Winter, and Spring sports seasons will be condensed into two seasons. Fall season will commence December 2020 and Spring season in March 2021. In addition, on August 3, 2020, the California Department of Public Health released an update to reinstate youth sports with specific quidelines. Social distancing with a stable cohort must be adhered to, activities must be performed outside, conditions should focus on individual skill building to limit person to person contact. Santa Ana Unified School District will allow coaches to be processed and hired. Risk Management will purchase student athlete medical insurance so athletes can be cleared to participate in athletic conditioning competitions. All students athletes will be given access to virtual athletic conditioning competitions via their athletic coaches who will be supervised by a certificated staff member. Athletic Directors will schedule athletic competitions, secure venues and student transportation. In-person conditioning will occur as soon as the local health agency deems Santa Ana Unified School District students are safe to participate in these activities, and we are comfortable as a District that we are able to provide the proper space and gear.

WHEREAS, the Projects consist of the construction and installation of underlit solar carports or shade structures on either the existing parking lots, playfield, or hardscape areas of the existing District sites. The maximum height of the carports and shade structures is 12.9 feet, with an approximately 2% to 5% tilt. The Projects will also include removal of non-native, ornamental trees from either the playfield or hardscape areas. Certain campuses will include a battery energy storage system enclosed in ground-mounted cabinet; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at Romero-Cruz Academy will include three solar carport structures located on the southwestern portion of the site in the parking lot, one solar shade structure located on the southeastern portion of the site near the playfield and hardscape

area, 12 inverters, and other associated equipment. The battery energy storage system of 51 in. \times 38 in. \times 87 in. will be located on the southwestern portion of the site. Approximately three non-native, ornamental trees will be removed; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at Abraham Gonzalo and Felicitas Mendez Fundamental Intermediate School will include four solar shade structures located on the northwestern portion of the site in the playfield area, nine inverters, and other associated equipment. The battery energy system of 51 in. x 38 in. x 87 in. will be located on the northern central portion of the campus; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at Thomas Jefferson Elementary School will include two solar shade structures located on the southern portion of the campus in the playfield area, 10 inverters, and other associated equipment. The battery energy storage system of 51 in. \times 38 in. \times 87 in. will be located on the northern portion of the campus; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at Abraham Lincoln Elementary School will include two solar shade structures located on the southeastern corner of the site near the hardscape and playfield area, four inverters, and other associated equipment. The battery energy storage system of 51 in. x 38 in. x 87 in. will be located on the southwestern portion of the campus. Approximately two non-native, ornamental trees will be removed; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at Glenn L. Martin Elementary School will include three solar carport structures located on the eastern portion of the campus in the parking lot, seven inverters, and other associated equipment. The battery energy storage system of 51 in. \times 38 in. \times 87 in. will be located on the eastern portion of the site. Approximately one non-native, ornamental tree will be removed; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at Adeline C. Walker Elementary School will include two solar carport structures, one located on the northwestern portion of the campus in the parking lot and one located on the southeastern portion of the campus in the parking lot, five inverters, and other associated equipment. The battery energy storage system of 51 in. x 38 in. x 87 in. will be located on the western portion of the site. Approximately one non-native, ornamental tree will be removed; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at the District Administration Site will include six solar carport structures located on the northern parking lot, 20 inverters, and other associated equipment. The battery energy storage system of 51 in. x 38 in. x 87 in. will be located on the northern parking lot; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at John Muir Fundamental Elementary School will include two solar shade structures located on the

 northeastern portion of the campus in the playfield area, five solar carports located along the western portion of the campus in the parking lots, seven inverters, and other associated equipment. The battery energy storage system of 51 in. x 38 in. x 87 in. will be located on the western portion of the site. Approximately 12 non-native, ornamental trees will be removed; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at Raymond A. Villa Fundamental Intermediate will include four solar carport structures located on the eastern portion of the campus in the parking lots, eight inverters, and other associated equipment. Approximately three non-native, ornamental trees will be removed; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at Sierra Preparatory Academy will include two solar shade structures located along the eastern and southern edges of the hardscape play area, five inverters, and other associated equipment. The battery energy storage system of 51 in. \times 38 in. \times 87 in. will be located on the southeastern portion of the campus. Approximately one non-native, ornamental tree will be removed; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at the Fairview Facilities Building will include seven solar carport structures, three located on the western portion of the site in the parking lot and four located on the eastern portion of the site in the parking lots, nine inverters, and other associated equipment; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at Wallace R. Davis Elementary School will include one solar carport structures located on the northwestern portion of the campus in the parking lot, one solar shade structure located on the northeastern portion of the campus in the hardscape and playfield area, five inverters, and other associated equipment. Approximately two non-native, ornamental trees will be removed; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at Roosevelt Elementary School will include one solar shade structure located along the western edge of on the eastern playfield, one solar carport structure located on the northwestern parking lot, five inverters, and other associated equipment. Approximately three non-native, ornamental trees will be removed; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at James Russell Lowell Elementary School will include three solar carport structures located on the southeastern portion of the campus in the parking lot, one solar shade structure located on the western portion of the campus on the hardscape area, four inverters, and other associated equipment. Approximately ten non-native, ornamental trees will be removed; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at Pio Pico Elementary School will include three solar shade structures located on the eastern portion

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of the campus along the border of the playfields, four inverters, and other associated equipment. Approximately one non-native, ornamental tree will be removed; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at John F. Kennedy Elementary School will include five solar carport structures, two located on the western parking lot, two located on the southwestern parking lot, and one located in the northern parking lot, six inverters, and other associated equipment. Approximately two non-native, ornamental trees will be removed; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at Julia C. Lathrop Technology Magnet Intermediate School will include four solar carport structures located on the northwestern parking lot, 10 inverters, and other associated equipment. Approximately one non-native, ornamental tree will be removed; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at Manuel Esqueda Elementary School will include two solar carport structures located on the eastern parking lot, one solar shade structure located on the western portion of the campus in the playfield area, one solar shade structure on the central hardscape play area, 12 inverters, and other associated equipment. Approximately five non-native, ornamental trees will be removed; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at Santiago Elementary School include three solar shade structures, two located on northwestern corner of the campus and one located on the southern end of the campus on the hardscape play area, four inverters, and other associated equipment; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at James Madison Elementary School will include three solar carport structures located on the northern and eastern parking lots, one solar shade structure located on the northern edge of the southeastern playfield, five inverters, and other associated equipment. Approximately eight non-native, ornamental trees will be removed; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at James Monroe Elementary School will include two solar shade structures located on the southern half of the campus on the playfield's southern edge and hardscape areas, 4 inverters, and other associated equipment. Approximately four nonnative, ornamental trees will be removed; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at Diamond Elementary School will include two solar shade structures located on the eastern portion of the campus on the hardscape and playfield areas, three inverters, and other associated equipment. Approximately one non-native, ornamental tree will be removed; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at Thomas A. Edison Elementary School will include one solar carport structure located on the southeastern parking lot, one solar shade structure located on the southern edge of the northern playfield area, three inverters, and other associated equipment. Approximately five non-native, ornamental trees will be removed; and

WHEREAS, Solar/photovoltaic system at Heroes Elementary School will include three solar carport structures located on the western parking lot, two inverters, and other associated equipment; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at Greenville Fundamental School will include two solar carport structures located on the southern parking lot, one solar shade structure located along the southern edge of the northeastern playfield, 10 inverters, and other associated equipment. Approximately nine non-native, ornamental trees will be removed; and

WHEREAS, Solar/photovoltaic system at John Adams Elementary School will include three solar carport structures located on the southeastern parking lot, one solar shade structure located on the western portion of the hardscape play area, six inverters, and other associated equipment; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at Andrew Jackson Elementary School will include three solar carport structures located on the western parking lots, five solar shade structures, one located on the southwestern portion of the campus on the hardscape play area, one located on the northern portion of the eastern playfield area, three located on southeastern portion of the campus on the hardscape play areas, 13 inverters, and other associated equipment. Approximately seven non-native, ornamental trees will be removed; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at Jose A. Sepulveda Elementary School will include one solar shade structure located along the western edge of the playfield, two inverters, and other associated equipment. Approximately four non-native, ornamental trees will be removed; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at Herbert Hoover Elementary School will include two solar carport structures located on the northern edge of playfield, three inverters, and other associated equipment. Approximately seven non-native, ornamental trees will be removed; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at Woodrow Wilson Elementary School will include one solar shade structure located on the central portion of the site in the hardscape area, two inverters, and other associated equipment; and

WHEREAS, solar/photovoltaic system at John C. Fremont Elementary

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School will include two solar shade structures located along the eastern edge of the hardscape play areas, two inverters, and other associated equipment. Approximately five non-native, ornamental trees will be removed; and

WHEREAS, before the District may determine to carry out the Projects, it must comply with the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") for each of the Projects. District staff have determined that the Projects meet the definitions of the Class 3, Class 11, and Class 14 Categorical Exemptions; and

WHEREAS, the Class 3 Categorical Exemption set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15303 exempts a project that consists of construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures and installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures; and

WHEREAS, the Class 11 Categorical Exemption set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15311 exempts a project that consists of construction or placement of minor structures accessory to existing commercial, industrial, or institutional facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Projects consist of the construction and installation of solar energy systems that comprise a limited number of new relatively small structures and accessory structures (i.e., solar carports, solar shade structures, battery storage cabinets) on existing public District administrative and school campuses, which are institutional and in an urban, built-up environment; and

WHEREAS, the Class 14 Categorical Exemption set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15314 exempts a project that consists of minor additions to existing schools within existing school grounds where the additions do not increase original student capacity by more than twentyfive percent (25%) or ten (10) classrooms, whichever is less; and

WHEREAS, with the exception of the District Administration Site and Fairview Facilities Building, the solar/photovoltaic systems would be minor additions to existing schools that do not increase any school's student capacity; and

WHEREAS, none of Projects will increase student capacity because none of the Projects change the physical space for housing students, since each one of the Projects is a solar/photovoltaic system and associated equipment to generate and supply solar energy to each respective school campus; and

WHEREAS, the District has reviewed of each the Projects considered whether individually, each of the Projects

significant environmental impacts due to unusual circumstances, and determined that none exist for any of the Projects.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, for good and sufficient cause based on the entire record of proceedings, the Santa Ana Unified School District Board of Education ("Board") hereby resolves, determines, and finds the following:

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> The above recitals are true and correct. Α.

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Each of the Projects meets the definition of the Class 3 Categorical Exemption (CEQA Guidelines, § 15303), because each of the Projects consists of the construction and operation of a solar/photovoltaic system containing a limited number of new small facilities or structures on an existing administration or school sites.

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Each of the Projects, meets the definition of the Class 11 Categorical Exemption (CEQA Guidelines, § 15311), because each of the Projects consists of the construction of minor structures accessory to existing institutional facilities.

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Each of the Projects, except for the Projects located at the District's Administration Site and Fairview Facilities Building, meets the definition of the Class 14 Categorical Exemption (CEQA Guidelines, § 15314), because each of the Projects consists of minor additions to an existing school site that will not increase original student capacity by more than twenty-five percent (25%) or ten (10) classrooms.

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There is no indication of unusual circumstances that would cause a potentially significant environmental impact related to any of the Projects.

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The applicable requirements of CEQA have been fulfilled for each of the Projects.

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The Superintendent or the Superintendent's designee is authorized and directed to file a Notice of Exemption for the Projects with the Orange County Clerk within five (5) days of the adoption of this Resolution.

Supplementary Retirement Program for All Employees for 2021-22 School Year Administered by Public Agency Retirement Services

WHEREAS, it is determined to be in the best fiscal interest of the District and its employees to provide a retirement incentive offer to eligible employees who wish to voluntarily exercise their option to separate from District Service;

WHEREAS, there is no cash option available to employees in lieu of this retirement incentive offer;

WHEREAS, Public Agency Retirement Services (PARS) has made available to the District a Supplementary Retirement Plan, a retirement incentive program supplementing STRS/PERS, and qualifying under the relevant sections of Section 403(b) of the Internal Revenue Code;

WHEREAS, the District, pursuant to applicable policy and/or a collective bargaining agreement, desires to adopt the Supplementary Retirement Plan and to fund the incentive through nonelective employer contributions to the PARS designated 403(b) provider.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Governing Board of Education of the District hereby adopts the PARS Supplementary Retirement Plan, as part of the District retirement program, effective August 25, 2020; and
- 2. The retirement incentive must meet the District's fiscal and operational objectives in order for the plan to go into effect. If these goals are not reached, the District may withdraw the retirement incentive. If the District withdraws the retirement incentive, resignations may be rescinded; and
- 3. The Board of Education of the District hereby appoints the Assistant Superintendent, Business Services, or his/her successor or his/her designee as the District's Plan Administrator; and

4. The District's PARS Plan Administrator is hereby authorized to execute the contracts, custodial agreement facilitating the payment of contributions to the 403(b) arrangement, and other legal documents related to a trust or the plan on behalf of the District and to take whatever additional actions are necessary to maintain the District's participation in the plan and to maintain compliance of any relevant regulations issued.
