SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Almendarez acknowledged the community's concern regarding the reopening and return to play plan. He announced that there would be two presentations tonight regarding both of those concerns. He added that COVID-19 rates are declining, and that the District is in the 8.5-9% rate. He stated that if trends continue, we would be that much closer to reopening in some sort of hybrid model. Superintendent shared that the Governor has allowed for cohorts of students that meet certain criteria to be present. Staff is currently working out all the details to ensure a safe environment for students and staff. Superintendent thanked the community, families, and students for their patience during these challenging times. He shared that he has attended community meetings where parents have expressed

their concerns regarding connectivity issues. The District did pilot buses with Wi-Fi connectivity in certain spots with some success in and is excited to expand those services to other areas of the District. Superintendent Almendarez encouraged families to keep calling the hotline for assistance and help. Staff is available whether it is for a hot spot device, a Chromebook, or iPad. He also thanked teachers as they also have faced challenges. Teachers are coming in and working remotely. There is a Learning Continuity Plan which we are required to comply with at the state level and regulres for assessments to be taken. Families and students have been very frustrated with the platform as well as teachers, Superintendent stated that staff is working closely with the agency that provides this platform to work out all the bugs. Mr. Almendarez also stated that grades are coming up and that we have to take into consideration all the issues we have been challenged with as a community and as a household. The Board and SuperIntendent's expectation is that we be compassionate and reasonable when administering grades. He encouraged parents, students, and teachers to do the best they can do with regard to grades. Superintendent also stated that we are getting closer to stage 2 but many of the surrounding districts are already in that phase right now. We are preparing as much as we can to provide safe spaces for students to return, for parents to feel comfortable, and ensuring we are providing a safe working environment for staff as well. He added that the District will do stage 2 mindfully with the intent to start slow and to gradually work it's way up making sure the opportunities are there for the safety and cleanliness of our district. Superintendent announced the administrative appointment of Brandon Peterson, Coordinator of Special Education Services.

10	of textbooks and instructional materials in order to be eligible to receive funds for that purpose, and;
11	WHEREAS, the procedures require that school districts take appropriate action to ensure the
12	availability of textbooks and instructional materials on a yearly basis, and;
13	WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Sections 60119, the Board is required to hold a public hearing
14	to encourage participation by parents, teachers, members of the community interested in the affairs of the
15	school district, and bargaining unit leaders, and;
16	WHEREAS, the Board is required to provide 10 days' notice of the public hearing or hearings, and;
17	WHEREAS, the notice shall contain the time, place, and purpose of the hearing and be posted in three
18	public places within the school district, and;
19	WHEREAS, the hearing shall be held at a time that will encourage the attendance of teachers and
20	parents and guardians of pupils who attend the schools in the district and shall not take place during or
21	immediately following school hours, and;
22	WHEREAS, the governing Board of a school district, as part of the required hearing, shall also make
23	a written determination as to whether each pupil enrolled in a foreign language or health course has sufficient
24	textbooks or instructional materials that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum
25	frameworks adopted by the state board for those subjects, and;
26	WHEREAS, the governing Board shall also determine the availability of laboratory science equipment
27	as applicable to science laboratory courses offered in grades 9 to 12, inclusive, and;

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on <u>September 22, 2020</u>, at <u>6:00 p.m.</u> o'clock, which is on or before the eighth week of school and;

WHEREAS, the Board is required to make a determination, through a resolution, as to whether each pupil in each school in the district has, sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are aligned to the content standards adopted pursuant to Education Code Section 60605 and Education Code 33126 in each of the following subjects, as appropriate, that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board:

- (i) Mathematics,
- (ii) Science,
- (iii) History-social science,
- (iv) English/language arts, including the English language development component of an adopted program,
 - (v) Visual and performing arts. (Not listed in 60605 or 33126)

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the governing Board makes the determination that each pupil of the district, has available sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are aligned to the content standards adopted pursuant to Education Code Section 60605 and Education Code Section 33126 in each subject listed above, consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board and adopted by this Board in accordance with the procedures as established.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that for the 2020-21 school year, the Santa Ana Unified School District, has provided each pupil with sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are aligned to the content standards adopted pursuant to Education Code Section 60605 and Education Code Section 33126 in each subject listed above, consistent with the content and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board for those subjects.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that for the 2020-21 school year, the Santa Ana Unified School District has provided sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the state board, to each pupil enrolled in a foreign
