#### SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Almendarez addressed the employee pay situation. He apologized to employees who have been negatively impacted and did not receive a paycheck. Mr. Almendarez also apologized to staff in the payroll and human resource department, Principals, community, and Board of Education for putting the District in an unacceptable position. Mr. Almendarez provided a COVID testing update. He shared that testing continues to roll out throughout the district and reported that to date, the District has tested close to 12,000 students. He encouraged parents and staff to sign consent forms and that paper forms are available at school sites. He added that the COVID test is a cheek swab which is safe, fast, and causes little to no discomfort. Superintendent Almendarez encouraged all K-12 families to participate in College night Wednesday, October 6, 2021.

#### 9. PRESENTATION

##### 9.1 Board Priorities Update

Superintendent Almendarez provided a presentation on the Board Priorities. He asked for Board feedback. Board members asked questions, provided individual feedback, and asked for additional information to be brought back in December that includes a fully articulated graduate profile, clearly distinguish how Key Performing Indicators (KPI's) are covering how they are going to measure that the graduate profile has been achieved, clearly distinguish how student progress and efficiency of system effectiveness is being measured, turn indicators into measurable and directional outcomes, immediate and intermediate focus within each priority area, identify the pressure points in the five domains that will help release the tension and feel relief, and the values the Superintendent is going to lead with.

#### 10. PUBLIC HEARING

##### 10.1 California Voting Rights Act

Dr. Rodriguez opened up the meeting to conduct a public hearing for the California Voting Rights Act. He welcomed everyone to the meeting. He explained that the purpose of the public hearing is to provide the community with

information regarding the CVRA and to receive public input from the public on the criteria that should be used to draw the boundaries for the five trustee areas that will be drawn. He added that after the second public hearing the District's demographer will provide the Board with several maps reflecting the public input that the Board has received. The Board will then hold a third and fourth public hearing to receive public input on the proposed maps. At a subsequent meeting, the Board will then make a decision on which map to adopt.

Dr. Rodriguez touched on a few major points. The CVRA is a state law which prohibits at-large voting systems that impair the ability of racial or ethnic minorities to elect the candidate of their choice. The CVRA favors district-based election systems in which candidates must reside in a trustee area and only the voters residing in that trustee area vote for those candidates. This means that beginning in 2022, voters in those trustee areas up for election in 2022 will vote for one candidate in their trustee area and the remaining trustees will hold an election in 2024. The change in the election system will not affect school attendance boundaries.

President Rodriguez introduced Mr. Ronald Wenkart, legal counsel, to provide additional information. Mr. Wenkart gave a brief presentation related to the CVRA process. He introduced demographers Angela Banuelos and Jonathan Portocarrero from Cooperative Strategies. Ms. Amezcua requested that moving forward the community be better informed including mail outs. Dr. Rodriguez requested an additional public hearing at a Special Board meeting. Board discussed and came to a consensus that the public hearings would be conducted as Special Board meeting at different school sites to be televised and pushed out on social media and parent square. Mr. Wenkart will send the Superintendent tentative dates and Superintendent's staff will poll the Board on their availability.

## BOARD REPORTS

She also asked for additional information regarding resources for families that have children that are being sent home and do not have a doctor.

Dr. Alvarez reminded everyone of College Night on October 6. He asked that support and resources be provided for Special Education students who are in Virtual Academy. Dr. Alvarez also added that additional CVRA public hearings will be held.

Mr. Palacio asked tha the pay issues be resolved now. He asked who in the District is managing the COVID testing. In addition, he asked staff to address the grading issue now.

Ms. Torres affirmed her support of ethnic studies and anti-racism. She asked staff to look into how to further train teachers. She shared about a recent shooting in the area of Carver and Heroes and asked staff for a mental health and counseling check.

Dr. Rodriguez announced that it was college application season and wished students and counselors luck and to reach out for support. Dr. Rodriguez asked Ms. Amezcua if she would like to make the request for presentation. Ms. Amezcua requested a presentation on COVID Protocols to maintain the continuity of learning. Dr. Rodriguez commended the community and staff who are doing a great job at keeping the community safe. Dr. Rodriguez also commented on the anti-ethnic studies comment.

14 WHEREAS, the Board of Education (the "Board of Education") of the Santa Ana  
15 Unified School District (the "School District"), as legislative body of the Community  
16 Facilities District (defined below), formed Community Facilities District No. 2004-1  
17 (Central Park Project) of the Santa Ana Unified School District (the "Community  
18 Facilities District") on September 28, 2004 under the provisions of the Mello-Roos  
19 Community Facilities Act of 1982, constituting Sections 53311 et seq. of the

31 principal amount of its Community Facilities District No. 2004-1 of the Santa Ana  
32 Unified School District (Central Park Project) 2015 Special Tax Refunding Bonds (the  
33 "Prior Bonds"), pursuant to a Bond Indenture, dated as of July 1, 2015, by and between  
34 the Community Facilities District and The Bank of New York Mellon Trust Company, N.A.,  
35 as trustee thereunder;

36 WHEREAS, the Board of Education, acting as the legislative body of the Community  
37 Facilities District, has determined that debt service savings can be achieved by  
38 refunding the outstanding Prior Bonds, outstanding as of the date hereof in the  
39 aggregate principal amount of \$6,335,000;

40 WHEREAS, in order to provide funds to refund the outstanding Prior Bonds, the

**WHEREAS**, the moneys to defease and redeem the Prior Bonds will be applied to such purpose pursuant to an Escrow Agreement by and between the Community Facilities District and The Bank of New York Mellon Trust Company, N.A., as prior trustee and as escrow bank (such Escrow Agreement, in the form presented to this meeting, with such changes, insertions and omissions as are made pursuant to this Resolution, being referred to herein as the "Escrow Agreement");

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education, as legislative body of the Community Facilities District, has determined in accordance with Government Code Section 53360.4 that a negotiated sale of the Refunding Bonds to Stifel, Nicolaus & Company, Incorporated, as underwriter (the "Underwriter") in accordance with the terms of the Purchase Agreement (defined below) approved as to form by this Board of Education herein will result in a lower overall cost to the Community Facilities District than a public sale; and

**WHEREAS**, the Underwriter has presented the Community Facilities District with a proposal, in the form of a Bond Purchase Agreement, to purchase the Refunding Bonds from the Community Facilities District (such Bond Purchase Agreement, in the form presented to this meeting, with such changes, insertions and omissions as are made pursuant to this Resolution, being referred to herein as the "Purchase Agreement");

**WHEREAS**, Rule 15c2-12 promulgated under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 ("Rule 15c2-12") requires that, in order to be able to purchase or sell the Refunding Bonds, the underwriter thereof must have reasonably determined that the issuer thereof has, or one or more appropriate obligated persons have, undertaken in a written agreement or contract for the benefit of the holders of the Refunding Bonds to provide disclosure of certain financial information and certain enumerated events on an ongoing basis;

**WHEREAS**, in order to cause such requirement to be satisfied, the Community Facilities District desires to enter into a Continuing Disclosure Agreement with a dissemination agent (such Continuing Disclosure Agreement, in the form presented to this meeting, with such changes, insertions, omissions as are made pursuant to this Resolution, being referred to herein as the "Continuing Disclosure Agreement");

**WHEREAS**, a form of the Preliminary Official Statement to be distributed in connection with the public offering of the Refunding Bonds has been prepared, which Preliminary Official Statement contains certain information regarding the Community Facilities District, the School District, the Indenture and the Refunding Bonds (such Preliminary Official Statement, in the form presented to this meeting, with such changes, insertions and omissions as are made pursuant to this Resolution, being referred to herein as the "Preliminary Official Statement");

**WHEREAS**, there have been prepared and submitted to this meeting the forms of:

- a) the Indenture;
- b) the Escrow Agreement;
- c) the Purchase Agreement;
- d) the Continuing Disclosure Agreement; and

100 **WHEREAS**, the Community Facilities District desires to issue and sell the  
101 Refunding Bonds and to authorize the execution of such documents and the performance

**Section 3.** (a) The Indenture, in substantially the form submitted to this meeting and made a part hereof as though set forth herein, is hereby approved. Each of the President of the Board of Education, and such other members of the Board of Education as the President may designate, the Superintendent of the School District (the "Superintendent"), the Deputy Superintendent, Educational Services of the School District, the Assistant Superintendent, Business Services and the Assistant Superintendent, Facilities and Governmental Relations of the School District, and such other officer or employee of the School District as the Superintendent may designate (the "Authorized Officers") is hereby authorized, and any one of the Authorized Officers is hereby directed, for and in the name of the Community Facilities District, to execute and deliver the Indenture in the form submitted to this meeting, with such changes, insertions and omissions as the Authorized Officer executing the same may require or approve, such requirement or approval to be conclusively evidenced by the execution of the Indenture by such Authorized Officer; provided, however, that such changes, insertions and omissions shall not result in the aggregate principal amount of the Refunding Bonds being greater than \$6,500,000, shall not result in the final maturity date of the Refunding Bonds being later than September 1, 2035 and shall not result in a true interest cost for the Refunding Bonds in excess of 5.00%.

(b) The Refunding Bonds shall be executed on behalf of the Community Facilities District by the manual or facsimile signature of the President of the Board of Education of the School District, and attested with the manual or facsimile signature of the Secretary to Board of Education of the School District.

(c) The covenants set forth in the Indenture are hereby approved, shall be deemed to be covenants of the Board of Education, in its capacity as the legislative body of the Community Facilities District, and shall be complied with by the Community Facilities District and its officers.

**Section 4.** The refunding of the Prior Bonds is hereby approved. In accordance with Section 53363.8 of the Act, the Board of Education hereby designates the following costs and expenses as the "designated costs of issuing the refunding bonds:"

a. all expenses incident to the calling, retiring, or paying of the Prior Bonds and incident to the issuance of the Refunding Bonds, including the charges of any agent in connection with the issuance of the Refunding Bonds or in connection with the redemption or retirement of the Prior Bonds;

b. the interest upon the Prior Bonds from the date of sale of the Refunding Bonds to the date upon which the Prior Bonds will be paid pursuant to call; and

c. any premium necessary in the calling or retiring of the Prior Bonds.

**Section 5.** The Escrow Agreement, in substantially the form submitted to this meeting and made a part hereof as though set forth in full herein, is hereby approved. Each of the Authorized Officers is hereby authorized, and any one of the Authorized Officers is hereby directed, for and in the name of the Community Facilities District, to execute and deliver the Escrow Agreement in the form presented to this meeting, with such changes, insertions and omissions as the Authorized Officer executing the same may require or approve, such requirement or approval to be conclusively evidenced by the execution of the Escrow Agreement by such Authorized Officer.

192       **Section 6.** (a) The Purchase Agreement, in substantially the form submitted to  
193 this meeting and made a part hereof as though set forth in full herein, is hereby  
194 approved. Each of the Authorized Officers is hereby authorized, and any one of the  
195 Authorized Officers is hereby directed, for and in the name of the Community Facilities  
196 District, to execute and deliver the Purchase Agreement in the form presented to this  
197 meeting, with such changes, insertions and omissions as the Authorized Officer  
198 executing the same may require or approve, such requirement or approval to be  
199 conclusively evidenced by the execution of the Purchase Agreement by such Authorized  
200 Officer; provided, however, that such changes, insertions and omissions shall not  
201 result in an aggregate Underwriter's discount (not including any original issue  
202 discount) from the principal amount of the Refunding Bonds in excess of 1.75% of the  
203 aggregate principal amount of the Refunding Bonds.

204       (b) The Board of Education hereby finds and determines that the sale of the  
205 Refunding Bonds at negotiated sale as contemplated by the Purchase Agreement will  
206 result in a lower overall cost.

207       (c) For purposes of Government Code section 5852.1, good faith estimates of  
208 (a) the true interest cost of the Refunding Bonds; (b) the costs associated with the  
209 issuance of the Refunding Bonds; (c) the amount of proceeds to be received by the  
210 Community Facilities District (less the costs of issuance or reserves or capitalized  
211 interest, if any); and (d) the total payments amount, including the total principal  
212 of and interest on the Refunding Bonds through the final maturity thereof, and all  
213 fees and charges to third parties, not paid with proceeds of the Refunding Bonds, are  
214 set forth on **Exhibit A** attached hereto and incorporated herein.

215       **Section 7.** The Continuing Disclosure Agreement, in substantially the form  
216 appended to the Preliminary Official Statement and made a part hereof as though set  
217 forth in full herein, be and the same is hereby approved. Each of the Authorized  
218 Officers is hereby authorized, and any one of the Authorized Officers is hereby  
219 directed, for and in the name of the Authority, to execute and deliver the Continuing  
220 Disclosure Agreement in the form presented to this meeting, with such changes,  
221 insertions and omissions as the Authorized Officer executing the same may require or  
222 approve, such requirement or approval to be conclusively evidenced by the execution  
223 of the Continuing Disclosure Agreement by such Authorized Officer.

224       **Section 8.** The Preliminary Official Statement, in substantially the form  
225 presented to this meeting and made a part hereof as though set forth in full herein,  
226 with such changes, insertions and omissions therein as may be approved by an Authorized  
227 Officer, be and the same is hereby approved, and the use of the Preliminary Official  
228 Statement in connection with the offering and sale of the Refunding Bonds is hereby  
229 authorized and approved. The Authorized Officers are each hereby authorized to certify  
230 on behalf of the Community Facilities District that the Preliminary Official Statement  
231 is deemed final as of its date, within the meaning of Rule 15c2-12 (except for the

233 Rule 15c2-12). The preparation and delivery of a final Official Statement containing  
234 information regarding the Community Facilities District, the Indenture and the  
235 Refunding Bonds (the "Official Statement"), be and the same is hereby authorized and  
236 approved. The distribution by the Underwriter of the Preliminary Official Statement  
237 and the Official Statement to persons who may be interested in the purchase of the  
238 Refunding Bonds is hereby authorized and approved. The information regarding the  
239 Community Facilities District, the Indenture and the Refunding Bonds contained in the  
240 Official Statement shall be in substantially the form of that contained in the  
241 Preliminary Official Statement, with such changes, insertions and omissions as may be  
242 approved by an Authorized Officer.

243       **Section 9.** The assessed values of the property within the Community Facilities  
244 District are set forth in the Preliminary Official Statement and the value-to-lien  
245 information with respect thereto is set forth therein and, based thereon, the Board  
246 of Education, for purposes of Section 53345.8 of the Act, hereby finds and determines  
247 that the value of the real property that would be subject to the Special Tax to pay  
248 debt service on the Refunding Bonds will be at least three times the principal amount  
249 of the Refunding Bonds to be sold and the principal amount of all other bonds  
250 outstanding that are secured by a special tax levied pursuant to the Act on property  
251 within the Community Facilities District or a special assessment levied on property

253       **Section 10.** The Board hereby confirms the designation of (i) Dannis Woliver  
254 Kelley, as bond counsel and disclosure counsel to the School District and the Community  
255 Facilities District, (ii) Fieldman, Rolapp & Associates Inc., as financial advisor to  
256 the School District and the Community Facilities District, and (iii) Cooperative  
257 Strategies, as special tax consultant to the School District and the Community  
258 Facilities District, each in accordance with those certain professional services  
259 agreements previously entered into between the School District and each such

261       **Section 11.** (a) The Authorized Officers and the officers and employees of the  
262 School District are, and each of them is, hereby authorized and directed, for and in

267       (b) Each of the Authorized Officers are authorized, but not required, to

269 and, if it is necessary or advisable in order to improve said rating, to obtain a  
270 municipal bond insurance policy guaranteeing payment of principal and interest with  
271 respect to some or all of the Refunding Bonds and/or to obtain a debt service reserve  
272 policy with respect to the Refunding Bonds, and to pay the premium or fee therefor  
273 from the proceeds of the sale of the Refunding Bonds, if such Authorized Officer, in  
274 consultation with the financial advisor of the Community Facilities District,  
275 determines that obtaining such rating, municipal bond insurance policy, or debt  
276 service reserve policy will result in a lower total interest cost with respect to the  
277 Refunding Bonds. The Authorized Officers are further authorized to enter into such  
278 agreements, and execute such documents, as shall be necessary to secure such rating  
279 and/or insurance policies.

280       **Section 12.** All actions heretofore taken by the officers and employees of the  
281 School District in connection with or related to any of the agreements or documents  
282 referred to herein, are hereby approved, confirmed and ratified.

283       **Section 13.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

ENHANCING SUPPORTS AND RESOURCES FOR OUR LGBTQ+ STUDENTS

**WHEREAS**, the Santa Ana Unified School District prides itself on its diversity and inclusiveness, providing safe and welcoming spaces for students, regardless of race, ethnicity, national origin, language, disability status, gender expression or identity, and sexual orientation; *and*

**WHEREAS**, on June 15, 2020, in a landmark decision for lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer/questioning (LGBTQ) persons, the U.S. Supreme Court gave recognition to the LGBTQ community of individuals and they should enjoy the protection of the law; *and*

**WHEREAS**, President Biden issued an Executive Order in March of 2021 declaring that it was his administration's policy to guarantee an educational environment free from discrimination on the basis of sex, including discrimination on the basis of sexual orientation or gender identity; *and*

**WHEREAS**, President Biden, in his Executive Order, stated that this guarantee was codified, in part, in Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, which prohibits discrimination on the basis of sex in education programs or activities receiving federal financial assistance; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Education's Office of Civil Rights has stated, in a *Notice of Interpretation*, that Title IX applies to protect students from discrimination based on sexual orientation and gender identity; *and*

**WHEREAS**, state law, under the FAIR Education Act, Senate Bill 48, requires that California K-12 schools provide Fair, Accurate, Inclusive and Respectful (FAIR) representations of people with disabilities and people who are lesbian, gay, bisexual, or transgender in our curricula, and requires the inclusions of LGBTQ history in kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade education; *and*

**WHEREAS**, federal and local policies and practices are increasingly acknowledging and focusing on LGBTQ youth and numerous national advocacy and other organizations are giving greater attention to LGBTQ youth in their work. Acceptance and support for all youth, including those who are LGBTQ, make communities and schools safer places; *and*

**WHEREAS**, as many as 10.3 percent of California students in middle and high schools identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, questioning, intersex, asexual, gender nonconforming, gender fluid, and gender nonbinary (LGBTQ+); *and*

**WHEREAS**, youth identifying as LGBTQ+ are overrepresented in the populations of youth experiencing homelessness; youth who are the victims of bullying and discrimination, including,

among other things, someone trying to convince them to change their sexuality or gender identity; and youth who have attempted or died as a result of suicide; *and*

**WHEREAS**, all children and youth should be able to attend school in a safe and inclusive environment free from discrimination; *and*

**WHEREAS**, every school district, including ours, must continue to do more to ensure our LGBTQ+ youth have the supports and resources they need to achieve academically and feel socially, emotionally, mentally, and physically safe at school; *and*

**WHEREAS**, for youth identifying as LGBTQ+, the District understands the importance of supporting a student's gender identity by providing a safe and inclusive school climate and promoting appropriate resources, including an individualized Gender Identity Support Plan. The purpose of the Gender Identity Support Plan is to identify the individual needs of identified LGBTQ+ students in accordance with the School Success and Opportunity Act (Assembly Bill AB1266). We are committed to advocating for safe and supportive environments for ALL students, regardless of gender, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression; *and*

**WHEREAS**, among other supports, the District has developed a memorandum of understanding with the LGBTQ Center OC to ensure that all LGBTQ+ youth and students in the District have access to community resources, education, and social services through various available programs; the District has developed a memorandum of understanding with Kinder Future to support District-wide programming to address the unique needs of all LGBTQ+ youth and their families and, thereby, improving school climates and culture by providing access to professional development for SAUSD support staff working with LGBTQ+ students and/or families,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Santa Ana Unified School District remains committed to inspire equity, create alliances, celebrate diversity, and establish safe environments in our schools and communities;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of Trustees of the Santa Ana Unified School District recognizes October 2021 as LGBT History Month, October 11 as National Coming Out Day, and November 20 as Transgender Day of Remembrance to honor the many achievements and contributions of the LGBTQ+ community, National Day of Silence on April 8, 2022, as a movement against the harassment and bullying of individuals identifying with the LGBTQ+ community, celebrating June 2022 as LGBTQ+ Pride Month.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Board of Trustees encourages all schools to incorporate lessons on the LGBTQ+ community in instruction and hold other commemorative activities in honor of LGBT History Month in October 2021, as well as during the above-mentioned commemoration days.
