SANTA ANA BOARD OF EDUCATION

April 28, 2020

CALL TO ORDER

Ms. Amezcua called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Other members on the call were Dr. Alvarez, Mr. Palacio, and Ms. Torres.

Cabinet members on the call were Superintendent Almendarez, Dr. Jimenez, Dr. Stekol, Dr. Allen, Dr. Helguera, Dr. Llamas, Dr. Martinez, Mr. Roychowdhury, Chief Smith, and Mr. Williams.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Superintendent Almendarez led the Pledge of Allegiance.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Almendarez announced that all schools have canceled all end of the year activities. All schools are working hard to find ways to recognize the students. There are a lot of virtual graduations that are in the making. He reassured the community that everyone is doing everything they can so that students get the recognition they deserve. In addition, staff is working on finding ways for students to pick up their personal items and equipment and also finding ways for teachers to do the same. In doing so, students and staff members are asked to practice safe social distancing. Scheduling will be spaced out while students and staff are on campus. In closing the school year, staff is preparing summer school instruction as well as preparing for the beginning of next school year. There are a couple of options with a combination of distance learning as well as physical presence on campus, being mindful of the social distancing requirements. Superintendent added that there is still a lot to do, but everyone is working hard to try to make this transition as smooth as possible. The District will continue to support the community with meals as well as with the instruction component. He added that staff is also looking for ways to increase support with student connectivity access for their devices.

**AUTHORIZATION TO INCREASE IN STATUTORY SCHOOL FEES IMPOSED ON  
RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL CONSTRUCTION PURSUANT TO  
EDUCATION CODE SECTION 17620 AND GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 65995**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education (“Board”) of the Santa Ana Unified School District (“District”) provides for the educational needs for Grade K-12 students within the City of Santa Ana, City of Tustin, City of Irvine, City of Costa Mesa, City of Newport Beach (“Cities”), and unincorporated portions of the County of Orange (“County”);  
and

**WHEREAS**, on January 22, 2020 the State Allocation Board authorized an adjustment in the statutory school fee amounts for unified school districts pursuant to Government Code Section 65995(b)(3) to Four and 08/100 Dollars (\$4.08) per square foot for assessable space of residential construction (“Residential Statutory School Fees”), Sixty-Six Cents (\$0.66) per square foot of chargeable covered and enclosed space for the categories of new commercial/industrial construction (“Commercial/Industrial Fees”), collectively “Statutory School Fees”), as long as such increases are properly justified by the District pursuant to law; and

**WHEREAS**, residential, and commercial/industrial continues to generate additional students for the District’s schools and the District is required to provide school facilities (“School Facilities”) to accommodate those students; and

**WHEREAS**, overcrowded schools within the District have an impact on the District’s ability to provide an adequate quality education and negatively impact the educational opportunities for the District’s students; and

**WHEREAS**, the District does not have sufficient funds available for the construction or reconstruction of the School Facilities, including acquisition of sites, construction of permanent School Facilities, and acquisition of interim School Facilities, to accommodate students from residential and commercial/industrial construction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has received and considered reports entitled, “Residential Development School Fee Justification Study and Commercial/Industrial Development School Fee Justification Study (“Studies”) which include information, documentation, and analysis of the School Facilities needs of the District, including: (a) the purpose of the Statutory School Fees; (b) the use to which the Statutory School Fees are to be put; (c) the nexus (roughly proportional and reasonable relationship) between the residential and commercial/industrial construction and (1) the use for Statutory School Fees, (2) the need for School Facilities, (3) the cost of School Facilities and the amount of Statutory School Fees from residential and commercial/industrial construction; (d) a determination of the impact of the increased number of employees anticipated to result from the commercial/industrial construction (by category) upon the cost of providing School Facilities within the District; (e) an evaluation and projection of the number of students that will be generated by residential construction; (f) the School Facilities that will be required to serve such students; and (g) the cost of such School Facilities; and

51           **WHEREAS**, the Studies pertaining to the Statutory School Fees and to the capital facilities  
52 needs of the District has been available to the public for at least ten (10) days before the Board  
53 considered at a regularly scheduled public meeting the increase in the Statutory School Fees; and

56           **WHEREAS**, all notices of the proposed increase in the Statutory School Fees have been  
57 given in accordance with applicable law; and

59           **WHEREAS**, a public hearing was duly held at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Board  
60 relating to the proposed increase in the Statutory School Fees on April 28, 2020; and

62           **WHEREAS**, as to the Statutory School Fees, Education Code Section 17621 provides that  
63 the adoption, increase or imposition of any fee, charge, dedication, or other requirement, pursuant to  
64 Education Code Section 17620 shall not be subject to the California Environmental Quality Act,  
65 Division 13 (commencing with Section 21000) of the Public Resources Code.

67           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF**  
68 **THE SANTA ANA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:**  
69

70           **Section 1.**       That the Board accepts and adopts the Studies.  
71

72           **Section 2.**       That the Board finds that the purpose of the Statutory School Fees imposed  
73 upon residential construction are to fund the additional School Facilities required to serve the  
74 students generated by the residential construction upon which the Statutory School Fees are  
75 imposed.  
76

77           **Section 3.**       That the Board finds that the Statutory School Fees imposed on residential  
78 construction will be used only to finance those School Facilities described in the Studies and related  
79 documents, and that these School Facilities are required to serve the students generated by the  
80 residential construction within the District; and that the use of the Statutory School Fees will  
81 include construction or acquisition of additional School Facilities, remodeling existing School  
82 Facilities to add additional classrooms, and technology, and acquiring and installing additional  
83 portable classrooms and related School Facilities, with the specific location of new schools,  
84 remodeling of existing School Facilities, and additional portables to be determined based on the  
85 residence of the students being generated by such residential construction, as well as any required  
86 central administrative and support facilities, within the District.  
87

88           **Section 4.**       That the Board finds that there is a roughly proportional, reasonable  
89 relationship between the use of the Statutory School Fees and the residential construction within the  
90 District because the Statutory School Fees imposed on residential construction by this Resolution  
91 will be used to fund School Facilities that will be used to serve the students generated by such  
92 residential construction.  
93

94           **Section 5.**       That the Board finds that there is a roughly proportional, reasonable  
95 relationship between the residential construction upon which the Statutory School Fees are imposed,  
96 and the need for additional School Facilities in the District because new students will be generated  
97 from residential construction within the District and the District does not have student capacity in  
98 the existing School Facilities to accommodate these students.  
99

102           **Section 6.**     That the Board finds that the amount of the Statutory School Fees imposed on  
103 residential construction as set forth in this Resolution is roughly proportional and reasonably related  
104 to, and does not exceed the cost of, providing the School Facilities required to serve the students  
105 generated by such residential construction within the District.  
106

107           **Section 7.**     That the Board finds that the purpose of the Statutory School Fees imposed  
108 on new commercial/industrial construction is to fund the additional School Facilities required to  
109 serve the students generated by the new commercial/industrial construction upon which the  
110 Commercial/Industrial Fees are imposed.  
111

112           **Section 8.**     That the Board finds that the Statutory School Fees imposed on new  
113 commercial/industrial construction (by category) will be used only to finance those School  
114 Facilities described in the Studies and related documents and that these School Facilities are  
115 required to serve the students generated by such new commercial/industrial construction; and that  
116 the use of the Statutory School Fees will include construction or acquisition of additional School  
117 Facilities, remodeling existing School Facilities to add additional classrooms and technology, and  
118 acquiring and installing additional portable classrooms and related facilities, with the specific  
119 location of new schools, remodeling of existing School Facilities, and additional portables to be  
120 determined based on the residence of the students being generated by such new commercial/  
121 industrial construction, as well as any required central administrative and support facilities within  
122 the District.  
123

124           **Section 9.**     That the Board finds that there is a roughly proportional, reasonable  
125 relationship between the use of the Statutory School Fees and new commercial/industrial  
126 construction by category within the District because the Statutory School Fees imposed on  
127 commercial/industrial construction by this Resolution will be used to fund School Facilities which  
128 will be used to serve the students generated by such new commercial/industrial construction.  
129

130           **Section 10.**    That the Board finds that there is a roughly proportional, reasonable  
131 relationship between the new commercial/industrial construction by category, upon which the  
132 Statutory School Fees are imposed, and the need for additional School Facilities in the District  
133 because new students will be generated from new commercial/industrial construction within the  
134 District and the District does not have student capacity in the existing School Facilities to  
135 accommodate these students.  
136

137           **Section 11.**    That the Board finds that the amount of the Statutory School Fees imposed on  
138 new commercial/industrial construction by category as set forth in this Resolution is roughly  
139 proportional and reasonably related to and does not exceed the cost of providing the School  
140 Facilities required to serve the students generated by such new commercial/industrial construction  
141 within the District.  
142

143           **Section 12.**    That the Board finds that a separate fund (“Fund”) of the District and two or  
144 more sub-funds (“Sub-Funds”) have been created or are authorized to be established for all monies  
145 received by the District for the deposit of Statutory School Fees and mitigation payments  
146 (“Mitigation Payments”) imposed on construction within the District and that said Fund and Sub-  
147 Funds at all times have been separately maintained, except for temporary investments, with other  
148 funds of the District as authorized by law.  
149

150           **Section 13.** That the Board finds that the monies of the separate Fund or the separate  
151 Sub-Funds described in Section 12, consisting of the proceeds of Statutory School Fees and  
152 Mitigation Payments have been imposed for the purposes of constructing and reconstructing  
153 those School Facilities necessitated by residential and/or commercial/industrial construction, and  
154 thus, these monies may be expended for all those purposes permitted by applicable law. The  
155 Statutory School Fees may also be expended by the District for the costs of performing any study  
156 or otherwise making the findings and determinations required under subdivisions (a), (b), and (d)  
157 of Section 66001 of the Government Code. In addition, the District may also retain, as  
158 appropriate, an amount not to exceed in any fiscal year, three percent (3%) of the fees collected  
159 in that fiscal year pursuant to Education Code Section 17620 for reimbursement of the  
160 administrative costs incurred by the District in collecting the Statutory School Fees.  
161

162           **Section 14.** That the Board hereby increases the Statutory School Fees as a condition  
163 of approval of residential development projects and imposes the Statutory School Fees on such  
164 development projects in the following amounts:  
165

166           a. Four and 08/100 Dollars (\$4.08) per square foot of assessable space for new  
167 residential construction, including residential projects, manufactured homes and mobile homes as  
168 authorized under Education Code Section 17625, and including residential construction or  
169 reconstruction other than new construction where such construction or reconstruction results in  
170 an increase of assessable space, as defined in Government Code Section 65995, in excess of five  
171 hundred (500) square feet.  
172

173           b. Sixty-Six Cents (\$0.66) per square foot of assessable space for new residential  
174 construction used exclusively for the housing of senior citizens, as described in Section 51.3 of  
175 the Civil Code or as described in subdivision (k) of Section 1596.2 of the Health and Safety  
176 Code or a multi level facility as described in paragraph 9 of subdivision (d) of Government Code  
177 Section 15432 or any mobile home or manufactured home that is located within a mobile home  
178 park, subdivision, cooperative or condominium for mobile homes limited to older persons as  
179 defined by the Federal Fair Housing Amendments of 1988.  
180

181           **Section 15.** That this Board hereby increases the Statutory School Fees as a condition  
182 of approval of new commercial/industrial construction projects and levies the Statutory School  
183 Fees on such development projects in the following amounts:  
184

185           a. Four and Eight-Tenths of a Cent (\$0.048) per square foot of assessable space for  
186 new self-storage construction.  
187

188           a. Sixty-Six Cents (\$0.66) per square foot of assessable space for new all other  
189 categories of commercial/industrial construction.  
190

191           **Section 16.** That the proceeds of the Statutory School Fees increased and established  
192 pursuant to this Resolution shall continue to be deposited into those Sub-Funds of the Funds  
193 identified in Section 12 of this Resolution, the proceeds of which shall be used exclusively for  
194 the purpose for which the Statutory School Fees are to be collected, including, as to Statutory  
195 School Fees, accomplishing any study, findings or determinations required by subdivisions (a),  
196 (b) and (d) of Section 66001 of the Government Code, or retaining an amount not to exceed in  
197 any fiscal year, three percent (3%) of the fees collected in that fiscal year pursuant to Education  
198 Code Section 17620 for reimbursement of the administrative costs incurred by the District in

199 collecting the Statutory School Fees or in financing the described Studies or in defending the  
200 imposition of Statutory School Fees.

201  
202 **Section 17.** That the District’s Superintendent, or designee, is directed to cause a copy  
203 of this Resolution to be delivered to the building officials of the Cities and the County along with  
204 a copy of all the supporting documentation referenced herein and a map of the District clearly  
205 indicating the boundaries thereof, advising the Cities and the County that residential and  
206 commercial/ industrial construction is subject to the Statutory School Fees increased pursuant to  
207 this Resolution and requesting that no building permit or approval for occupancy be issued by  
208 any of these entities for any residential development project, mobile home or manufactured home  
209 subject to the Statutory School Fees absent a certification of compliance (“Certificate of  
210 Compliance”) from the District demonstrating compliance of such project with the requirements  
211 of the Statutory School Fees, nor that any building permit be issued for any nonresidential  
212 construction absent a certification from this District of compliance with the requirements of the  
213 applicable Statutory School Fees.

214  
215 **Section 18.** That the Board hereby adopts and establishes the procedures that permit  
216 the party against whom the Commercial/Industrial Fees are imposed the opportunity for a  
217 hearing to appeal that imposition of Commercial/Industrial Fees for commercial/industrial  
218 construction as stated in Education Code Section 17621 and Government Code Section 66020  
219 and 66021.

220  
221 **Section 19.** That the Superintendent is authorized to cause a Certificate of Compliance  
222 to be issued for each development project, mobile home and manufactured home for which there  
223 is compliance with the requirement for payment of the Statutory School Fees in the amounts  
224 specified by this Resolution. In the event a Certificate of Compliance is issued for the payment  
225 of Statutory School Fees for a development project, mobile home or manufactured home and it is  
226 later determined that the statement or other representation made by an authorized party  
227 concerning the development project as to square footage is untrue or in the event the zoning is  
228 declared invalid, then such Certificate of Compliance shall automatically terminate, and the  
229 appropriate City or County shall be so notified.

230  
231 **Section 20.** That no statement or provision set forth in this Resolution, or referred to  
232 therein shall be construed to repeal any preexisting fee or mitigation amount previously imposed  
233 by the District on any residential or nonresidential construction. Notwithstanding the preceding,  
234 if the District adopts alternative school facilities fees for residential construction pursuant to  
235 Government Code Sections 65995.5, 65995.6 and/or 65995.7 (“Alternative School Facilities  
236 Fees”), the District is hereby authorized to collect the Alternative School Facilities Fees in lieu of  
237 the Statutory School Fee with respect to residential construction. If the Alternative School  
238 Facilities Fees should lapse or be terminated, then the Statutory School Fees shall be collected  
239 for residential construction at the amount set forth in this Resolution.

240  
241 **Section 21.** That if any portion or provision hereof is held invalid, the remainder  
242 hereof is intended to be and shall remain valid.

243  
244 **Section 22.** That the increase in the District’s Statutory School Fees will become  
245 effective sixty (60) days from the date of this Resolution unless a separate resolution increasing  
246 the fees immediately on an urgency basis is adopted by the Board.




