Superintendent's Report

Itzel Roman, ASB president for Santa Ana High School, shared some campus news including the 100 Years on Walnut celebration of the school's current location since 1912. The celebration will include year-long special events beginning with a Bill Medley benefit concert scheduled for December 15, 2011. The alumnus is a former member of the legendary Righteous Brothers duo.

To guide her in the process of listening, learning, and leading during her superintendency, working with the Board, Superintendent Thelma Meléndez de Santa Ana has created a 100-Day Entry Plan that covers specific goals and objectives to accomplish over the course of the next couple of months. Part of that process involves collecting input from various school district constituents via six small community engagement focus group meetings. These are not town hall formats. Rather the meetings will be more intimate to gather thoughts and opinions from parents, community members, partners, and staff members.
