

Rules, Expectations, & Classroom Policies

Class Materials

- Come prepared with your binder, agenda, reading book, **CHARGED** chromebook, and writing utensils.
- **Chromebooks** will be used nearly every day. **STAY** on task.
- **Backpacks** are to be kept on the floor, not your laps or on desks.
- Do not wear **airpods/headphones** unless instructed for an activity.

Late Work, Extra Credit, & Retakes

- **Late work** is accepted with an explanation. Please do your best to be **ON TIME**. Use a **LATE ASSIGNMENT FORM** if the assignment is digital/on GC.
- Assignments will be available on Google Classroom if extra credit is available. Do not ask for it.
- If you earn a **D/F** on a test or quiz, you will receive an opportunity to raise the grade. If you choose not to, it will remain a **D/F**.

Tardy Policy

Being on time means you are here in your assigned seat, in the room, ready to learn. You must sign your **tardy card** if you are late and do not have a signed pass.

6. AP Referral (Saturday School/Parent Contact)
7. AP Referral (Saturday School/Parent Contact)
8. Principal Referral (Attendance Contract)
9. Principal Referral (Next Steps, etc.)
10. Principal Referral (Probation, etc.)

Homework

- Your main homework is to complete **DAILY INDEPENDENT READING** with your book of choice. You are expected to carry your reading book daily (for in class reading)
- Any unfinished class work is considered homework. I will use a **TIMER** to help you to use your time effectively in class, so make sure to stay on task to reduce homework time at home.

- *We will use the Literacy Tracker in your agenda to record your scores & reflect/set goals.
