

NHBWA 2019 Educational Scholarship Guidelines

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

An application is considered <u>complete</u> only if it is accompanied by the following documents, which <u>must be submitted together with this Guidelines sheet.</u>

NHBWA is not responsible for materials lost or misdirected in the mail. <u>DO NOT SEND BY CERTIFIED MAIL.</u>

1. Sign this Educational Scholarship Guideline sheet and Submit ALONG WITH a completed Educational Scholarship Program Application Form.

2. Letters of Recommendation

- Each application shall include two (2) letters of recommendation, which must be attached or sent within the specified time frame. Both letters shall be from someone other than a family member who has known you for at least two (2) years and the other letter shall be from someone who has been influential to your success (e.g. faculty member, counselor, employer, minister, etc.)
- Letters must be on organization letterhead and shall include your name as it appears on this application. In addition, the letters must address the relationship
 to the applicant, length of time acquainted with applicant, applicant strengths and weaknesses and applicant's goals. Examples which elaborate on the
 applicant's commitment to the community, must also be addressed.

3. Essays

Each application must include two (2) essays. Each essay should be typed, double spaced, and titled with reference to the topic and not exceed two (2) pages.

ESSAY #1: The first essay shall be a personal narrative addressing the following:

• Describe your academic and professional goals, including contributions to your community.

ESSAY #2: Address one of the following topics (choose one only):

- The importance or value of obtaining a higher education
- The potential impacts or influences of a growing Latino population in relation to your field of interest
- The specific challenges faced by Latinas in pursuit of higher education

4. Copy of one of the following:

- Financial Aid Notification Letter
- Parents (or Self) 2017 or, 2018 Income Tax Return
- Student Aid Report
- 5. Official, sealed College/University Transcript(s) must be included with all application materials and no copies allowed.

APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- · Be a student residing in Southern California
- · In need of educational financial assistance
- · Participate in some form of community service
- Attending or planning to attend any accredited college or university in the USA
- Pursue an undergraduate or graduate degree
- Be a student in good standing with at least a 3.0 GPA or higher
- Must be at least a college or university Freshman status

CERTIFICATION
