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Find the derivative of each function below. Simplify your answer.

2	$y = \frac{2-x}{3x+1}$
3	$y = \frac{2}{(5x+1)^3}$
4	$f(x) = \frac{x}{\sqrt{1-x^2}}$
5	$f(x) = (x^2 - 2)(x^{-1} + 2)$
6	$y = 3x^2 + \frac{2}{x} - \frac{5}{x^2}$

Answer each question about tangents and normals.

7	Find the points on the curve $y = 2x^3 - 3x^2 - 12x + 20$ where the tangent line is parallel to the x -axis.
8	Find the slope of the normal to $f(x) = 2x^3 + x^2 - 1$ at the point where $x = \frac{1}{2}$
9	Find the equation of the tangent to $y = \sqrt{x^3 + 1}$ at the point where $x = 2$.
10	Find $\frac{dy}{dx}$ for $y = (x^2 + 1)(x^3 + 1)$, then find the slope of the normal when $x = -1$.
11	If the line $2x - y = 3$ is tangent to the function $f(x) = x^2 + 2x - 3$, what is the point of tangency?
12	At what x -value is $y = 3x - 1$ tangent to $f(x) = x^3 + 1$.

For #13-18, use the table below to find the indicated value

x	$f(x)$	$f'(x)$	$g(x)$	$g'(x)$
1	1	1	2	2
2	2	1	4	$\frac{3}{2}$
3	3	1	5	$-\frac{1}{2}$
4	4	1	3	$-\frac{3}{2}$
5	5	1	2	-1

14. Given $d(x) = f(x) - g(x)$, find $d'(3)$.

16. Given $q(x) = \frac{g(x)}{f(x)}$, find $q'(3)$.

17. Given $k(x) = (f(x))^2$, find $k(1)$.
