





- Gifted and Talented Education or GATE available in grades 3rd thru 5th






















AGREEMENT

Timeline and Registration Procedures:

- · Registration will be conducted by lottery
- Parents must submit an electronic lottery card <u>check EACH</u> of the
 2 fundamental elementary schools <u>you are interested</u> in
- Submit digital lottery cards:
 - Wednesday, January 10th thru Wednesday, January 24, 2024
 - Only adults may submit lottery card, one per child (except for twins or same grade level siblings get one lottery card




















Kinder Lottery cont'd Timeline and Registration Procedures:

- January 26, 2024: SAUSD computer center randomly selects the lottery numbers of those students who will be enrolled.
- January 30, 2024 Lottery results will be posted at each school and on the district webpage (please do not call the schools)
- February 22, 2024: If selected, parents MUST RESPOND VIA EMAIL TO THE SCHOOL INDICATING ACCEPTANCE TO ENROLL. PARENT will pick up enrollment registration forms at the selected school and return them by 4:00pm on 2/22/24.




If you are selected

- You will register your child online by 2/22/24.

 Instructions will be provided to families who are selected.
- When you <u>register</u> your child at one of the fundamental elementary schools, you will be dropped from the other fundamental school lists.

• If you are selected and you are coming from out of the district - you must get an Inter-District Transfer to attend the school site




