Middle College High School is an innovative dual enrollment school that partners with Santa Ana College. This partnership allows our students to get a personalized high school experience in a college setting. Dual enrollment offers our students a competitive advantage to prepare for the rigors of college and career.

WHO ARE WE?

- ◆ Small High School (380 students) inside Santa Ana College, 110 students are accepted into 9th grade
- ◆ All students are dual-enrolled at both MCHS and Santa Ana College.
- ◆ Mission is for each student to graduate with at least 30 units (1 year) college credit completed and attend a 4 year university.
- ◆ No cost for college classes and text-books
- ◆ College classes taught by college professors

- MCHS students have the opportunity to:
 1. Complete two years of college for free!
 2. Earn one or more A.A. Degrees and Certifications from Santa Ana College.
- Our school calendar matches the college calendar and may differ from SAUSD dates.
- Students have flexible scheduling and may have "free periods" throughout the day.
- Every student creates a personalized education plan.
- All students take AVID all 4 years.
- Must behave responsibly while on SAC campus. Breaking of Santa Ana College regulations may result in immediate removal from Middle College.

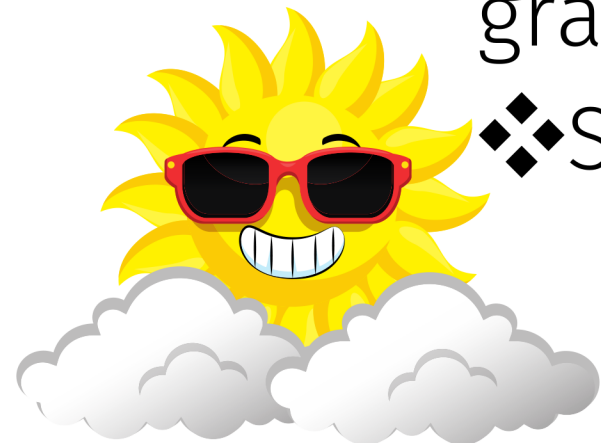
MCHS Requirements



- ❖ Attend school, on time, every day - both MCHS and SAC classes.
- ❖ Be prepared to study for and complete all high school and college coursework daily.



- ❖ Pass all classes with C or better (2.0 minimum GPA)
- ❖ Submit college & financial aid applications
- ❖ Be prepared to remain after school for additional support and instruction, if needed. (Mandatory Tutoring for any student with a grade below C).

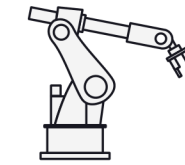

Campus Security

- ❖ MCHS is a “closed” campus – this means that the students do not have permission to leave the campus for any reason during the school day.
- ❖ MCHS has a District Service Officer & two activity supervisors who monitor the MCHS Campus and locker room area.
- ❖ MCHS and SAC Security work together to ensure student safety. Every student has access to emergency services through the RAVE/Guardian app.
- ❖ The students need to carry their MCHS and SAC identification cards with them at all times.
- ❖ Students must wear their MCHS lanyard at all times on campus.
- ❖ Students are to remain in approved areas on campus.
- ❖ Middle College students are not to interact or socialize with adult SAC students outside of their classes.
- ❖ Student stay in our after school program after 4:00pm



Lottery Dates

- ❖ November 21th – December 9th Accepting Lottery Applications online through our website
- ❖ December 12th Lottery Acceptance Posted on school website
- ❖ December 21th-Must complete Google Form Acceptance or invite will be recinded
- ❖ Students who were not selected in the lottery will be placed on a lottery waitlist for 1 year.
- ❖ If you accept a lottery invite to another school you will be taken off our waitlist.
- ❖ This process is only for 9th graders in 2023-2024

Parent Involvement

- ❖ All Parents are **REQUIRED** to attend the yearly grade level parent meeting!
- In addition, parents should:
- ❖ Help their child at home by providing an appropriate homework space.
- ❖ Make sure the student is here everyday on time.
- ❖ Utilize the **Aries Parent Portal** to monitor grades.
- ❖ Utilize **Parent Square** to contact school, teachers, or principal
- ❖ Attend Back to School Night (August) and Open House (March).
- ❖ Pick up your child promptly after school, tutoring, or college classes.
- ❖ Volunteer in activities such as PTSA, School Site Council, chaperone for dances, field trips and other events.
