In Onshape:

- 1. Right-click on part "PartStudio" tab in bottom left corner-
- Part Studio 1

- 2. Click on "Export..."
- 3. In "File name" give the file a name (color, part, name)
- 4. In "Format", change "PARASOLID" to STL by clicking and going down to STL
- 5. Change "Units" to "Millimeters" by clicking and going down to Millimeter
- 6. Leave everything else alone and click "OK" when you are done
- 7. This will download the file to your "Downloads" folder.
