


Doing two things at once, it turns out, can actually help focus the ADHD brain on a primary task. Experts believe that engaging in an activity that uses a sense other than what's required for your primary task can enhance focus and improve performance in children with attention difficulties. These secondary tasks are called *fidgets* ... mindless activities you can do while working on a primary task. Fidgeting is like pacing or doodling while on the phone, or chewing gum while taking a test. A fidget is self-soothing and helps you stay calm and focused. An effective fidget *doesn't distract you from your primary task* because it is something you don't have to think about.
