What is Early College?

Early college is a **FREE** program that allows incoming students to receive:

- An Associate's Degree for Transfer in Arts, Humanities and Communication
- Up to 60 semester units of college credit
- IGETC transfer pattern completion for CSU and UC general education requirements.



Why choose Early College?

Highlights of the Early College Program at Century include:

- A no-cost opportunity for all students, regardless of their income and background
- Provides students with a 'head start' on college credit while they attend high school
- Facilitates the transition into university where the student may complete a Bachelor's Degree
- Exposes students to rigorous college-level coursework



There's more!

- Many Early college classes are taught by SAC and Century teachers ON Century's campus
- Early College students have access to all SAC services and amenities
 - Student Health Services
 - Career Center
 - School Library and Tutoring
- Compared to AP classes
 - Early College classes still earn an extra point towards their GPA
 - Early College students do not rely on a single test score to earn college credit

Early College Criteria (9th)

The freshman early College Cohort is only open to **75** incoming 9th graders.

Students must have a **GPA of 3.0** and above.

Students **MAP scores (~200)** are **considered**

After being notified of acceptance, students will need to complete a SAC application for the Fall.



Commitment

Early college is a big commitment that challenges a student's ability to be responsible, independent, and consistent. In addition students must make sure it fits with **their** personal college and career goals.

Keep in Mind

- All SAC core academic classes meet IGETC requirements and are acceptable at all CSU and UC institutions
- Classes that meet IGETC requirements are **more likely but not guaranteed to be honored at private colleges.**
 - Avg. # of Accepted Units: 32
 - USC: 12
 - Stanford: 0
