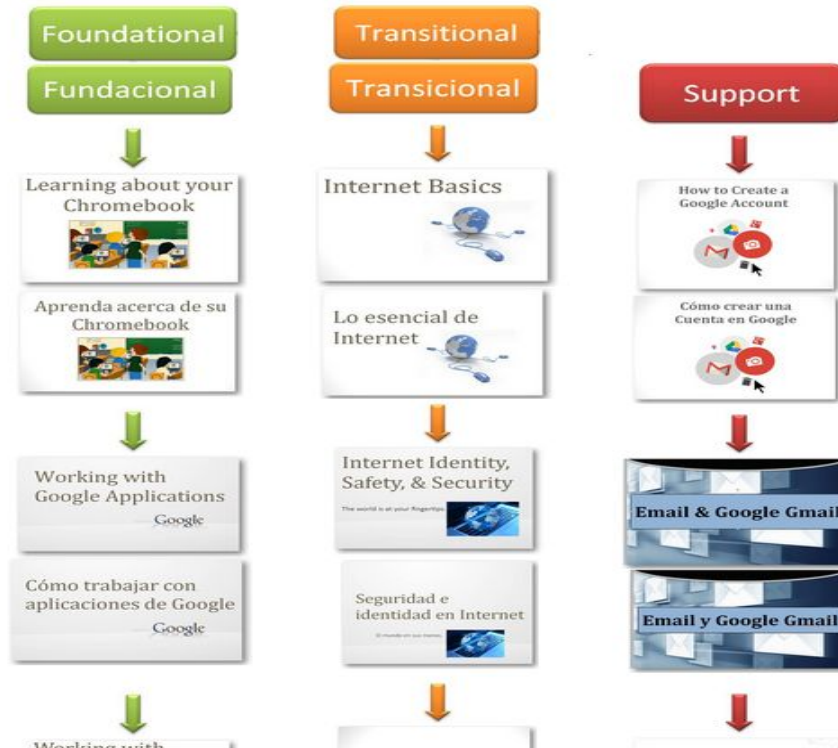

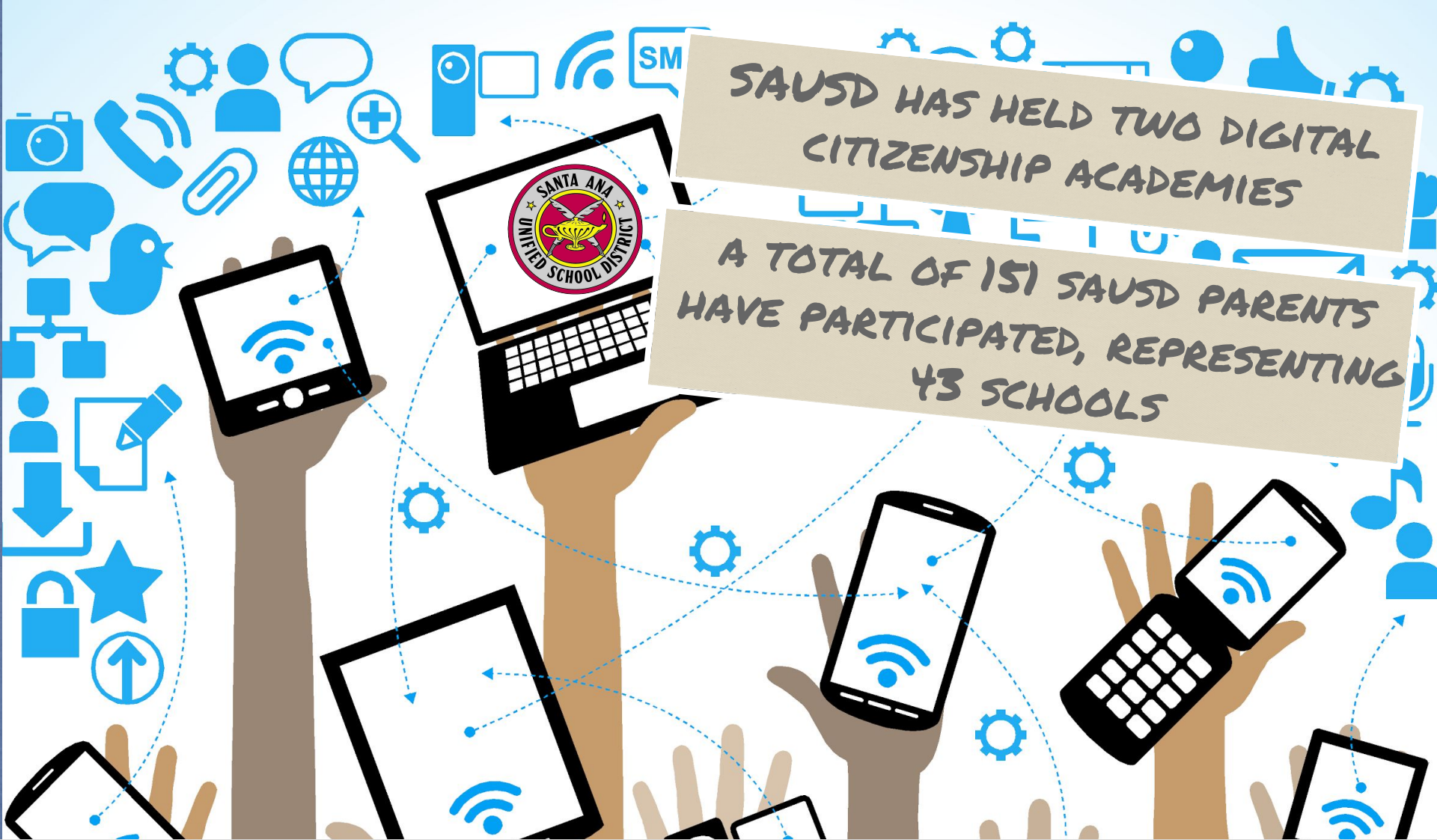


DIGITAL CITIZENSHIP ACADEMY

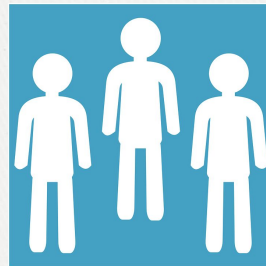
