## **Submission Criteria**

Websites will be automatically pulled from the Portal to be entered into the competition. To ensure you're entered in this competition, your website must be added to your Firm Profile in the Portal. Each element will be rated from 1 to 5 stars. A score of five is outstanding and a score of one needs significant improvement.

- First Impressions How well does the Employee Manual orient the employee to the company and its mission?
- *Purchasing* Add an item to the cart and proceed to checkout. How easily can a customer purchase a product or service? Judge based ease of finding the cart, and ease of adding an item to the cart.
- Overall Rate this category based on your analysis of the entire website. Does the design and layout of the website support what the business does? Is there content such as photos, videos, and/or links to social media accounts? What would you think about this website if it was for a real business?
