Task 2: Business Plan Preparation:

Review the California State guidelines with your team presentation found in the Trade Show Rubrics under the Regional Business Plan. Finalize your revised presentation that will be used in state business plan competition. Make sure you develop a presentation that covers each of the required areas found in the rubric. The presentation should be bullet points and not a lot of text to read. Convert the presentation to a PowerPoint file and make sure that the fonts and slide layouts are adjusted, as when you bring the file into PowerPoint it often changes the look. In addition, save the presentation in PDF and submit both files to Canvas and your Google Drive and set the slides to view offline. Create the supplementary material packets for the judges (4 pages) that highlight the most important sections of your presentation. Use the Sup Mats template found in the Task Matrix and print 6 copies finished packets. If this can be printed at the print shop in color. It is preferred. Teacher Signature

The teams will be released from period 4-6 to attend the event. Meet in the conference room after 3rd period.
