

## **ELEVATOR PITCH PRESENTATION Guidelines**

## DESCRIPTION OF EVENT

The Elevator Pitch Competition challenges VEI students to make a convincing and engaging "Elevator Pitch" in 90 seconds or less. What is an Elevator Pitch? You have a great idea you know will transform the world but you lack the resources to turn that idea into reality. You step onto an elevator in a high-rise building and recognize a group of venture capitalists in the elevator. You know we hold the key to providing you the necessary resources to build your dreams. This may be your only chance. You need to pitch your idea in a way that's interesting and concise enough to get us to say "We want to hear more. Let's set up an appointment." You don't have much time. The clock is ticking away.

## **GUIDELINES**

- Competitors will develop an oral Elevator Pitch for their Virtual Business
- One or two students maximum will represent the company
- Each company will be given 90 seconds to tell the judges about their company by painting a picture with words only
- The only hand-out from the presenter may be a business card to judges.
- No electronic equipment may be used!
