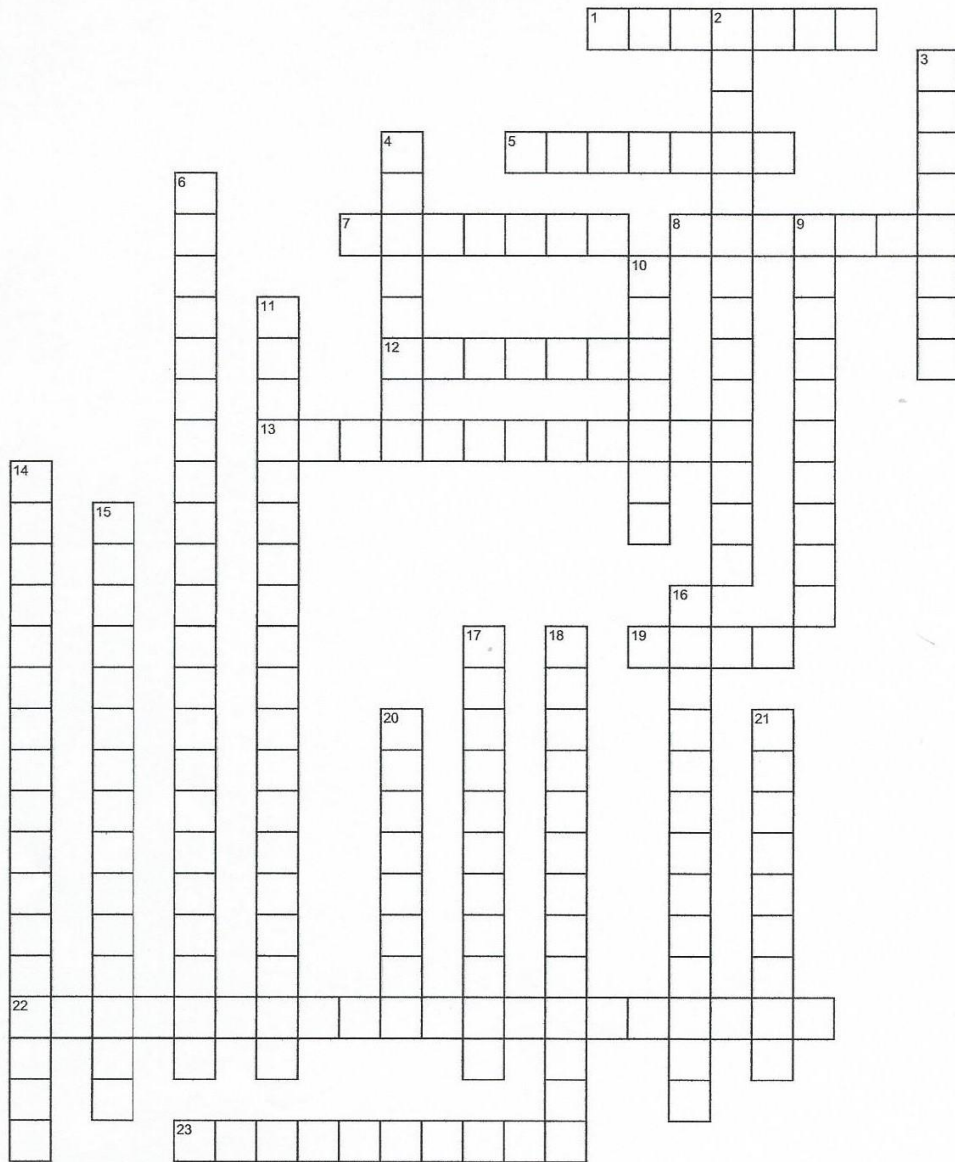


Chronic Disease: Diabetes
