


**Fever & Cough**

**ACROSS**

- 2 cancer of the lymph nodes
- 3 lung inflammation caused by bacterial or viral infection
- 4 a rapid release of air from the lungs, often to remove irritants or mucus
- 8 relating to or affecting breathing
- 9 low pitched, rattling lung sounds that suggest mucus or obstruction of the respiratory tract
- 10 known as 'kissing disease'; caused by the Epstein-Barr virus
- 11 the way something looks or the proportion of its features
- 13 an infectious disease caused by the herpes zoster virus; can re-emerge as Shingles later in life
- 14 the process by which living organisms change over time to assure survival
- 15 cavities or spaces within bones or tissue, notably in the face or skull; examples are the nasal cavities
- 16 small, bean-shaped organs located along the lymphatic system that filter bacteria and foreign particles from lymph fluid
- 17 an infectious viral disease causing fever and a red rash; more common in childhood

- 1 a malignant growth of abnormal cells
- 2 a large gland in the neck that secretes hormones affecting our metabolism
- 5 the presence of cancerous tumors
- 6 an infectious bacterial disease associated with growth of nodules in lungs; spread by coughing
- 7 normal noises from the abdomen from muscular contractions of peristalsis
- 9 the body's ability to fight off exposure to an infection or disease
- 12 a mixture of saliva and mucus resulting from infection or disease in respiratory tract
