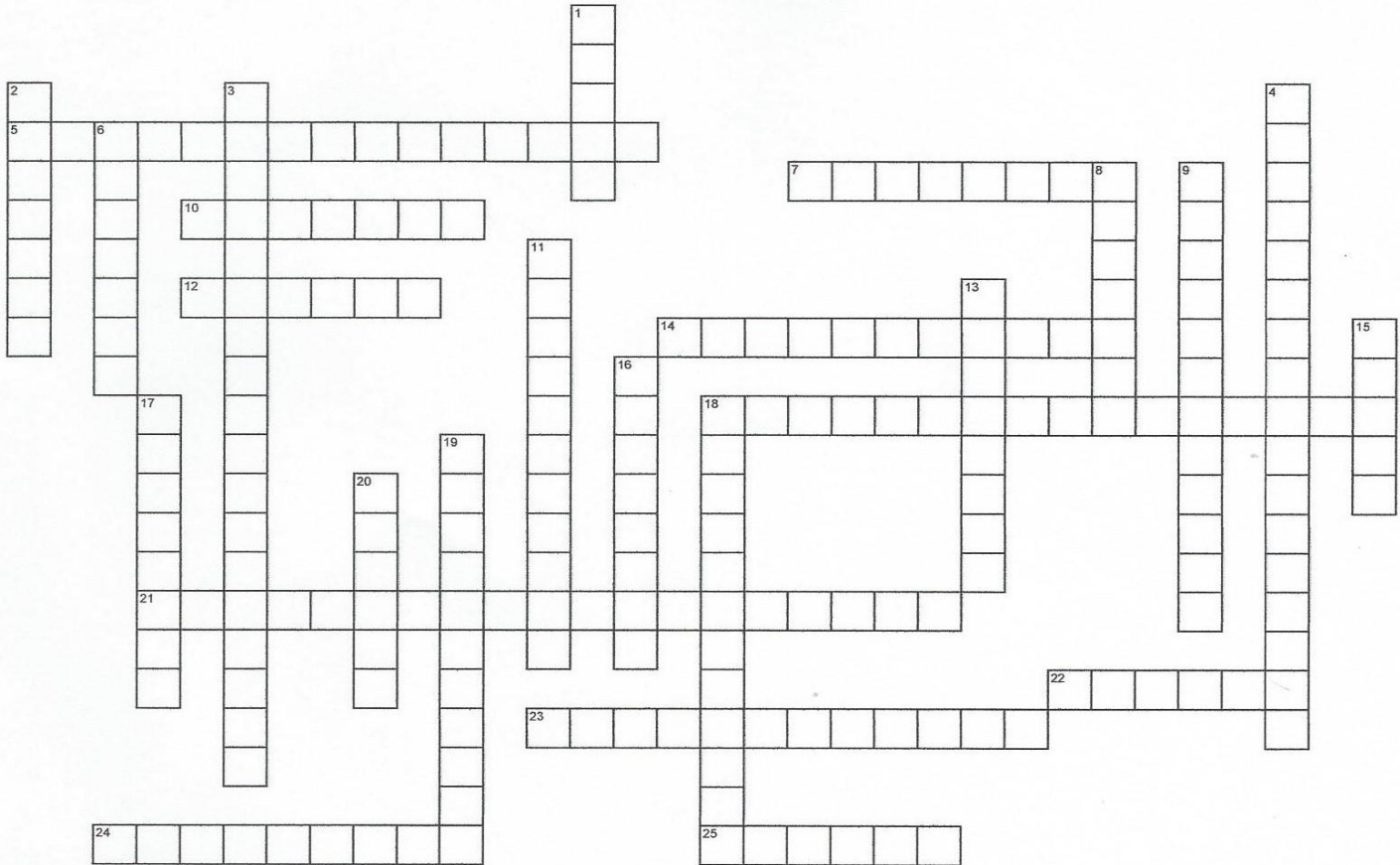

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**ACROSS**

- 5 area containing stomach and several other important organs
- 7 restriction of blood flow to tissue
- 10 lasting for weeks, months, or even longer
- 12 a flat stretcher on wheels used for transporting patients
- 14 the regular, rhythmic beating of the heart
- 18 near the appendix; often refers to an infection of or near the appendix
- 21 the outward expansion of the abdomen from the accumulation of gas or fluid; typically a symptom of disease or bodily dysfunction

- 6 wider, larger, or more open than normal
- 8 the part of the body containing the organs of food digestion
- 9 inflammation of the appendix
- 11 the normal noises made by the stomach and intestines as food moves during peristalsis
- 13 signs and feelings experienced by the patient that help guide the doctor to appropriate medical tests and a diagnosis
- 15 a measurement of heart rate
- 16 a ballooning of a blood vessel; represents a weakening of the vessel that could rupture
- 17 one section of the abdominal area when

- divided into four areas
- 18 inflammation of the pancreas
- 19 an infection of the bile duct; bile is important in digestion of fats
- 20 lying face upward
