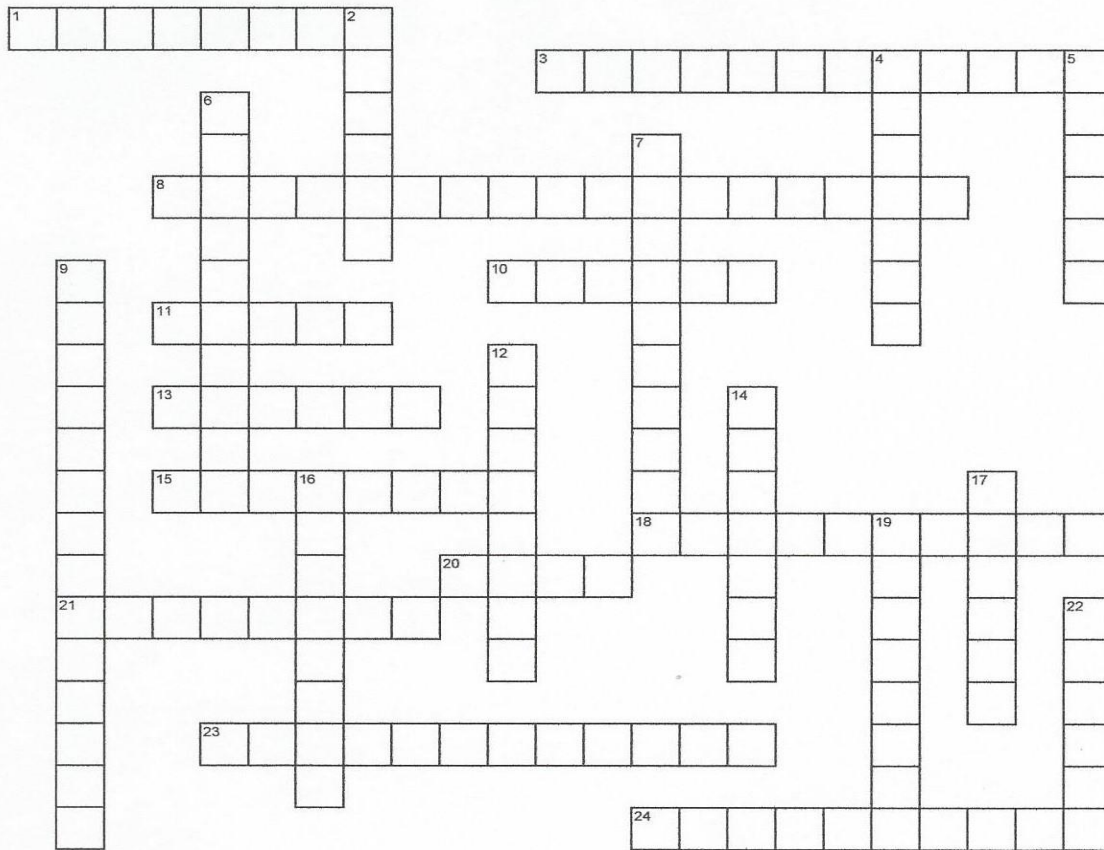

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ACROSS

- 1 a crack or break in a bone
- 3 a chronic disorder having symptoms of musculoskeletal pain, fatigue, and localized areas of tenderness
- 8 an autoimmune disease affecting the brain and spinal cord, causing impaired speech and muscle coordination
- 10 the part of the body located between the neck and the abdomen
- 11 temporary cessation of breathing, especially during sleep
- 13 occurs when blood flow to an area of the brain is disrupted by a clot or ruptured blood vessel
- 15 a group of symptoms that consistently occur together
- 18 feelings of severe despondency and dejection
- 20 a group of long, thin, curved bones that together make a boney cage that protects our vital organs

- 23 an instruction from a medical practitioner that authorizes a patient to receive a medicine or treatment

- 5 a condition of inadequate hemoglobin in blood or deficiency of red blood cells causing fatigue and pallor
- 6 dysfunction of peripheral nerves causing numbness or weakness
- 7 the use of sound waves to examine the fetus during pregnancy
- 9 a network of nerves that control movement and sensation to the shoulder, arms, and hands
- 12 the desire to eat
- 14 to examine the body by touch
- 16 inability to produce enough insulin causing elevated blood sugar
- 17 an examination of tissue removed from a body to discover the presence or extent of a disease
- 19 skin eruption and acutely painful nerve inflammation caused by the chicken pox virus and occurring in older people who had chicken pox previously; preventable with a vaccine
- 22 acronym for computed tomography scan; uses x-rays to make detailed pictures of the inside of the body
