MINUTES

REGULAR MEETING SANTA ANA BOARD OF EDUCATION

October 26, 2010

CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Board President Yamagata-Noji. Other members in attendance were Mr. Richardson, Mr. Hernández, and Mr. Palacio, and Mr. Reyna who arrived at 6:00 p.m.

Cabinet members present were Ms. Russo, Dr. Olsky, Mr. Lopez, Mr. Mendez, Ms. Miller, Ms. Lohnes, and Mr. Dixon. Mr. Bishop was not in attendance at the meeting due to District business.

PUBLIC PRESENTATIONS

Board President Yamagata-Noji asked those wishing to address the Board in matters pertaining to Closed Session to step to the podium.

There were no individuals wishing to comment at this time.

RECESS TO CLOSED SESSION

The Regular meeting recessed to Closed Session to consider negotiations, public employee discipline/dismissal, confidential issues, public employee performance evaluation, and personnel matters.

RECONVENE OPEN MEETING

The Regular meeting reconvened at 6:20 p.m.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance led by Sabrina and Suzette Sanchez, sisters from Segerstrom High School.

SUPERINTENDENT'S COMMENTS

Superintendent Russo shared a video clip of Eduardo "Lalo" Garcia, a football player for Century High School. His performance in the game against Fairmont Preparatory Academy was so impressive that NBC TV, Channel 4 sports reporter Fred Roggin contacted Century Head Coach Ted Crego to feature Garcia on his Roggin's Heroes segment highlighting high school football. Century won that that game 48 to 28. The television clip was shown during the meeting.

Ms. Russo welcomed Santa Ana High School Senior Cesar Galvez who has been the first and second Orange County finisher in two invitational meets and has led the varsity team to an overwhelming victory against Segerstrom High School. The Cross Country star stepped to the podium and described his motivation for athleticism. Cesar was recently named O.C. Register Athlete of the Week.

The Superintendent announced that SAUSD schools are observing Red Ribbon Week from October 25 through October 29. Various weeklong activities will be held to educate students about drug prevention and promote awareness of remaining a drug-free environment.

Ms. Russo called upon Mr. Dennis Cole and Reverend Chineta Goodjoin who invited the community to the Rhapsody of Love Benefit Concert on Sunday, November 14, 2010. New Hope Presbyterian Church of Orange is sponsoring the music event. The event will benefit music in Santa Ana schools, with a particular emphasis on Willard Intermediate. Headlining a host of talented musicians and Hollywood, guests will include the Santa Ana High School Jazz Band and Latin percussionist Poncho Sanchez. The Superintendent delivered the annual State of the District on Friday, October 22 to the Board, staff, and the Santa Ana community at McFadden Intermediate School. Tonight, she shared the annual address detailing accomplishments of the school district, students and staff members over the past year as well as recent successes and challenges that lie before the school district. She streamed through the theme "Setting our Course for Student Success" as she steered the course for SAUSD for the 2010-11 school year.

RECOGNITIONS

Above and Beyond the Call of Duty "ABCD" Award - Dr. Manuel Gómez, Ph.D.

The Superintendent, on behalf of the Santa Ana Unified School District, publicly recognized Dr. Manuel Gomez for his dedication to the Santa Ana Unified School District and community.

Dr. Gómez' early emphasis on collaboration has carried over into his work at UC Irvine, where he started in 1972 as a counselor and then director of the Educational Opportunity Program.

In the intervening years, Dr. Gómez has served as assistant and associate vice chancellor of enrollment services, and most recently as vice chancellor of student affairs before retiring in August 2010.

Dr. Gómez has been a significant contributor to the field of education and supporter of SAUSD students. In 1983, UCI was a founding partner of the nationally recognized Santa Ana Educational Partnership. This is an alliance of SAUSD, Santa Ana College, and California State University, Fullerton, which champions academic achievement, and college awareness and preparation among SAUSD graduates. Thanks to the work of the Santa Ana Partnership, 78% of all graduating seniors from SAUSD go on to attend college.

Dr. Gómez's work in the partnership includes authoring grants that brought funding to the SAUSD and the partnership from the Carnegie Foundation, California Academic Partnership Program, Ford Foundation, and

National Science Foundation, to mention a few. Those efforts total over \$30 million in support of our students.

The Superintendent highlighted the many ways in which he has supported SAUSD students, families and community members. Dr. Noji then paid tribute to Dr. Gómez for his outstanding service and dedication to the SAUSD. She noted how his influence has taken him to Washington D.C., to sit in some important meetings with many dignitaries on behalf of education.

On behalf of SAUSD, Board of Education, staff, parents, and students, Dr. Gómez was presented the Above and Beyond the Call of Duty Award.

PRESENTATIONS

Summarized Data of Williams Settlement First Quarterly Report

In order to meet the Williams Settlement Uniform Complaint Reporting requirements, staff is required to report summarized data on the nature and resolution of all complaints on a quarterly basis to the County Superintendent of Schools and Governing Board of school districts.

There were no complaints to report during the first quarter.

Budget Update

Mr. Tsunezumi updated the Board of Education on the State budget, impact to school districts, adopted State budget, and budget reductions.

The State Budget was approved 100 days after the start of the new fiscal year. This delay proposed a one-year suspension of Prop 98, eliminates negative 0.39% COLA and eliminates on-going revenue limit reduction of -3.85% which translates to \$13.8 million for SAUSD. The Jobs Bill award to the SAUSD is \$10.3 million (\$9.2 million already received.) In reference to the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (AARA) Stabilization, the State is to distribute the remaining 10% funds with an award of approximately \$2 million. He stated that utilizing the State adopted budget assumptions, preliminary projected budget reductions would be adjusted to \$18 million for 2011-12 and \$24 million for 2012-13 opposed to \$31.5 million in 2011-12 and \$30 million in 2012-13. He stated while the budgetary news is welcome, there are some concerns. He said that speculation is that the real budget may include significant cuts to education, and yet to be known until the budget is developed by the new Governor after elections or perhaps in the 2011 May Revise, therefore the SAUSD would continue to conserve.

In closing, Mr. Tsunezumi stated that the District would continue to work collaboratively with our CSEA and SAEA associations and bring reductions to the Board before December 15.

PUBLIC HEARING

SAUSD's Initial Bargaining Proposal to AFL-CIO Communications Workers of America

President Yamagata-Noji declared the meeting open to conduct a Public Hearing to receive comments regarding SAUSD's initial bargaining proposal to AFL-CIO Communications Workers of America.

President Yamagata-Noji asked those members of the community who wished to address the Board to step forward as she called their names.

Hearing no comments, the Public Hearing was closed.

PUBLIC PRESENTATIONS

Board President Yamagata-Noji asked those wishing to address the Board in matters pertaining to items on the Agenda to step to the podium.

Helen Martinez, SAUSD resident, addressed the Board to inform them and the community that she is the new PTA Council President. She offered her services to the community and District.

Venancio Chavez, SAUSD resident, addressed the Board to inform them of concerns with safety and security and that he is awaiting a return call from Chief Valentin.

Rocio Alvarado, SAUSD resident, addressed the Board to ask them for their assistance in attaining a reimbursement regarding her for her special needs child.

It was moved by Mr. Richardson, seconded by Dr. Yamagata-Noji, and carried 5-0 to authorize the award of a contract for the purchase of specialty paper supplies for the Publications Department for an amount of \$196,031.91 renewable annually for a period of up to three years, pursuant to Bid No. 5-11.

4.0 APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT TO FACILITIES AGREEMENT BETWEEN SANTA ANA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT AND EL SOL SCIENCE AND ARTS ACADEMY CHARTER SCHOOL

It was moved by Mr. Reyna, Seconded by Mr. Richardson, and carried 5-0, to approve the amendment to the Facilities Agreement as drafted.

5.0 AUTHORIZATION TO OBTAIN REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL AND FILE E-RATE FORM 470 REQUESTING SMARTNET MAINTENANCE FOR NETWORK EQUIPMENT DISTRICTWIDE

It was moved by Mr. Palacio, seconded by Mr. Richardson, and carried 5-0 to authorize obtaining a Request for Proposal and file E-Rate Form 470 requesting SmartNet maintenance for network equipment Districtwide.

6.0 AUTHORIZATION TO AWARD CONTRACT TO USA SHADE & FABRIC STRUCTURES, INC. FOR PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF SHADE STRUCTURES AT CENTURY HIGH SCHOOL UNDER OVERCROWDING RELIEF GRANT PROJECT

It was moved by Mr. Hernández, seconded by Mr. Richardson, and carried 5-0 to authorize the award of contract for purchase and installation of shade structures at Century High School to USA Shade & Fabric Structures, Inc., in the amount of \$247,839.52 utilizing San Joaquin County Office of Education Shade Structure Bid.

It was moved by Mr. Palacio, seconded by Mr. Hernandez, and carried 3-0, to approve the student teacher and internship agreements with Argosy University; Biola University; Brandman University; California State University, Fullerton; California State University, Long Beach; National University; Pepperdine University; University of California Irvine; University of Phoenix; University of California Riverside, and University of Southern California.

9.0 PERSONNEL ACTION

It was moved by Mr. Richardson, seconded by Mr. Palacio, and carried 5-0, to approve the Personnel Calendar in its entirety. A copy of the calendar is attached.

10.0 BOARD AND STAFF REPORTS/ACTIVITIES

Mr. Palacio:

• He said that there were over 500 people at the Hispanic Educational Endowment Fund (HEEF) event. Faculty from the SAUSD were Roselinn Lee from Valley High and Patricia Rendon from King Elementary. He said that the outstanding selection is a reflection of SAUSD teachers.

Mr. Reyna:

• The HEEF event was fantastic. He is appreciative of the monies raised for students.

- He announced Fremont Elementary School's jog-thon on Wednesday, November 3rd. In addition, would try to participate if his schedule allowed.
- He reminded parents to read to their children.

Mr. Richardson:

- He complimented staff for their efforts and execution of the State of the District event on October 29 at McFadden Intermediate School. He enjoyed the music by the choir under the direction of teacher Greg Ellis.
- The Boys and Girls Club held its annual gala on Saturday, October 23. They raised \$75,000!

- She thanked Alex Ito, Lisa Hinshaw, and everyone who worked on the State of the District. Valley High School served wonderful hors d'oeuvres. A local vendor purchased catering coats and hats with Valley High School embroidery on coats. Many thought caterers were a professional group. Building services did a wonderful job as well. Thanks to Duane Lundquist as well as Chief Valentin and others who had a part in the State of the District.
