### **Board Presentations**

**Santa Ana** *¡Adelante!* **Highlighted** – Santa Ana *¡Adelante!* is a partnership between the Santa Ana Unified School District, Santa Ana College (SAC) and California State University, Fullerton (CSUF) ensuring a pathway to college beginning in the 6th grade. The partnership guarantees participating students priority registration at SAC and guaranteed transfers to attend CSUF, where they will complete their bachelor's degree. The first group of SAUSD students to benefit from Santa Ana ¡Adelante! will be the graduating seniors from the Class of 2011. They will enter SAC this fall and transfer to CSUF in 2013 or 2014, depending on their ability to enroll in required transfer classes at SAC. <u>Read more...</u>

**California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE) Update** – Staff presented results from the March 2011 administration of the CAHSEE exam. Over the past three years, SAUSD has increased the percentage of students passing on the first administration of the test in Grade 10, which is the goal. Eighty percent of 10<sup>th</sup> graders scored 350 or above the pass rate in math and 77% met the pass rate in English Language Arts. All students must pass the State test to be eligible for graduation. <u>View Presentation</u>

## **Board Approvals**

• Approval of Renewal Agreement with Pivot Learning Partners for the 2011-12 School Year –. (Agenda Item 4.0) Board approved the agreement paving the way for Pivot Learning Partners to assist SAUSD's 19 secondary schools with improving academic achievement through training and coaching sessions for administrators, teachers and the District's Instructional Leadership Team during the 2011-12 school year.



- Board Policy (BP) 5118 and Administrative Regulation (AR) 5118 Open Enrollment Act Transfers (New: For First Adoption and Implementation) (Agenda Items 5.0 and 6.0) This BP and AR were adopted for implementation to keep SAUSD in compliance with federal and state regulations with regards to the Open Enrollment Act Transfers. This State act, which became effective January of 2010, enables students to transfer out of low performing schools as identified by the State Superintendent of Public Instruction in the school district and provide parents with more school options.
- Certification of Third Interim Financial Status (Qualified) (Agenda Item 7.0) Board approved certification of the third interim financial report with a qualified status as recommended by Business Services. This certification regarding the financial status of SAUSD is required to be submitted to the County Superintendent of Schools per Education Code Section 42131. The report indicates whether or not the District is able to meet its financial obligations for the remainder of this fiscal year and for the subsequent two fiscal years based on the financial information known as of April 30, 2011. Given the magnitude of recent State budget reductions, SAUSD may not be able to merit its financial obligations through the remainder of this fiscal year or for the next two. The Business Services team will present the Board with the preliminary budget for the 2011-12 school year at the June 14 Board meeting.
- Authorization to Issue Request for Proposals for Solar Power Purchase Agreement for Financial/Funding Services (Agenda Item 13.0) The Board approved issuing an RFP that would enable the Facilities staff to explore options with third party vendors to install more solar sites throughout the school district.
- Approval of Collective Bargaining Agreement With California School Employees Association, Chapter 41 for 2010-13 School Years (Agenda Item 15.0) Board approved.

**Longevity Service Awards** – The Board of Education and Superintendent Jane Russo congratulated 98 employees who have served SAUSD for 25, 30, 35 or 40 years. Honorees were recognized by the Board, before being treated to a reception where they enjoyed time with their family, friends and colleagues. Festive tunes were provided courtesy of the Godinez Fundamental High School Dixieland Band. Employees with 10, 15 and 20 years of service were recognized at their individual schools or work locations.
