BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The purpose of this agenda item is to seek Board approval of California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE) waivers for students with disabilities. Until December 2007, students with disabilities were eligible for a SB 267 state exemption from CAHSEE passage. This state exemption expired.

However, in accordance with California Education Code Section 60851 (c) and Board Policy 6162 and Administrative Regulations 6162.52, local school district governing boards may waive the requirement to pass the CAHSEE for students with disabilities. Eligible students who have passed one or both sections of CAHSEE with modifications listed on their Individualized Education Programs (IEP) and met other specific requirements are eligible.

RATIONALE:

To obtain a waiver, the site principal must certify to the local governing board that an IEP or 504 plan is in place requiring modifications and that sufficient course work in English, language arts and math related to the CAHSEE subject matters is completed or in progress. Principals must submit an individual score report indicating a passing score on CAHSEE while using the modification(s).
