BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The purpose of this agenda item is to seek Board approval to obtain bids for coach bus transportation services for field trips and athletic trips for various school sites.

RATIONALE:

At the October 25, 2005, Board meeting, the Board authorized staff to award a contract to Certified Transportation, pursuant to Bid #3-06. This bid expires on October 24, 2010.

Coach buses are used for long distance field trips and mountain trips because of the extra storage space and restrooms provided on-board. Coach buses are also used when athletic teams reach CIF or finals as a reward for the hard work of the players. Not all school bus providers have coaches in their fleets.

At the June 22, 2010, Board meeting the Board authorized staff to award a contract to J F K Transportation Co. Inc. for Navy Junior Reserve Officers Training Corps (NJROTC) and overflow field trip buses for trips that cannot be handled by Certified Transportation. At the July 27, 2010, Board meeting, the Board authorized staff to renew contracts for Durham School Services for hometo-school transportation, Certified Transportation for field trip services and Orange County Department of Education for emergency transportation services.

Staff recommends awards to four bidders in the amount of \$203,678 annually. These vendors were the lowest responsive, responsible bidders on an item-by-item basis. At the January 13, 2009, Board meeting the Board authorized staff to award a three year contract to Schoolwires for web hosting (contingent on E-Rate funding to Schoolwires), in the amount of \$219,825. Staff is requesting authorization to approve an addendum to this contract in order to increase the capacity of the website to include the following:

- Template Package: The template and related services is a one-time expense that will provide the District with the software services and resources necessary to bring an updated homepage look and simplified navigation to resources for our District community.
- Professional Services Service Credits. These services will allow the District to receive "just-intime" support on technical issues in order to meet Santa Ana School District's ongoing service needs. These service credits are a one-time cost that may be used for website support costs, and will carry over to the following year if not used.
- Centricity Package Upgrade Services Bundle. This upgrade is a one-time expense that will provide access to additional website features that will allow greater functionality for internal administration and management of the website. These internal administration features will also provide the District with an updated feature set that will be used toward the revision of the District homepage. The goal of the website service upgrade is aligned to enhancing and extending student, parent, and community communication resources in support of student academic achievement.
