### School: Franklin Elementary School

- 1) What is your site doing *differently* this year from last year to improve student achievement?
  - Conduct walk-throughs every day and several times during the day to see how instruction is delivered in the classroom.
  - Ensure lesson plans are addressing student needs aligned to the core and pacing charts, students are on task, teachers are ready to deliver instruction and classroom management is in place.
  - Using DIBELS, MAP and SBAC Data to differentiate instruction.
  - Created Intervention classes after school and on Saturday's.
  - Students are using chrome books in small groups as part of daily differentiated instruction.
  
- 2) What is your site doing this year that is considered *new* to improve student achievement?
  - Focusing on providing assistance needed to those students who are reading below grade level and grouped according to their needs.
  - Students are Progress Monitored every week. For students who are still struggling, teachers are required to conduct SST's inviting parents and Special Education teachers and as a team decide the best strategies to follow in order to help these students.
  - Intervention classes after school and Saturday mornings.
  - All staff is implementing the scholar tickets for positive reinforcement and achievement.
  - All students and staff are focusing on College Readiness by using college day Wednesdays to talk about the importance of college.
  
- 3) What is your site doing *more of* this year to improve student achievement?
  - Focus approach to meet the students' needs.
  - Kinder through third grade are doing "PALS" at least 3 times a week.
  - Core Curriculum strategies are also helping students to find evidence in the text.
  - Student groups and differentiated instruction
  - Using chrome books for typing practice & SBAC preparation.
  
- 4) What is your site doing *less of* this year to improve student achievement?
  - Reduced the number of suspensions and detentions due to Positive Behavior Intervention System.
  
- 5) What is your site doing this year that is *innovative* to improve student achievement?
  - Increasing technology by giving every class access to chrome books.
  
  - Using technology for presentations in the classroom
  
  - Using Data Tracker for Students to reflect on their present levels and potential goals.
  
  - Increasing parent participation through School Site Council, English Language Advisory Committee, Parenting classes, Counseling and community resources.
