- 1) What is your site doing *differently* this year from last year to improve student achievement?
  - Two parent training & involvement programs: Padres en Acción and Padres Unidos (new)
  - Facilitating daily 30 minute research-based (SIPPS, PALS, Rewards, Six-Minute Solution, etc.) intervention blocks for grades 1-3 Intensive & borderline strategic students in the classroom with the classroom teacher while core & strategic students go to the computer lab and work on Lexia, SmartyAnts, or MyOn Reader
- 2) What is your site doing this year that is considered *new* to improve student achievement?
  - Added a second parent program, Padres Unidos, including a community worker
  - Purchased SmartyAnts, an online program to enhance students' learning in the area of pre-literacy skills, phonics, decoding, and fluency
- 3) What is your site doing *more of* this year to improve student achievement?
  - Providing more parent training and involvement through the Padres Unidos program
  - Continuing to provide the parent program, Padres en Acción, that focuses on nutrition, exercise, and physical activities for students during recess
  - Expanding our PBIS program with a greater emphasis on college readiness and character development
  - Purchasing more Chromebooks so that 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> graders have 1:1 access to technology; K-2 will have more Computer Lab access for ST Math, SmartyAnts, Lexia, MyOn Reader, etc.
- 4) What is your site doing *less of* this year to improve student achievement?
  - Following and reading from old content standards-based TE's
  - Using the existing SAXON Math program, as it doesn't relate to the new CCSS
- 5) What is your site doing this year that is *innovative* to improve student achievement?
  - Purchased MyOn Reader, an online program that provides students access to more books via the internet at school and home
  - Establishing an e-book reading center with tables, chairs, and Chromebooks where students will access MyOn Reader and read e-books of interest
