ROOM 204 CLASS PROCEDURES 

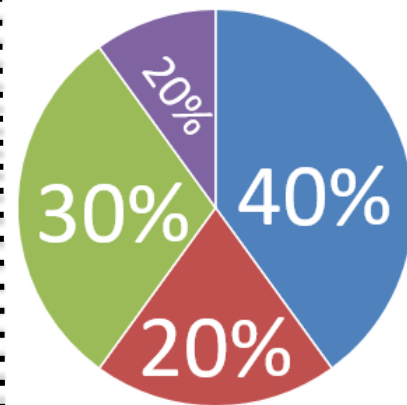
1. *Be on time!* - You must be in your seat when the bell rings.
2. *Work together* – This is a group-based class. You are expected to learn to work with others and not leave anyone behind. Encourage and support each other. Don't say "easy!"
3. *Be attentive* – Take notes, participate in discussion, and work on assigned task.
4. The bell does not *excuse* you!
5. *Use electronics responsibly*. - Your phone should be in silent mode in the pouch and you should be on the correct web pages when using your Chromebook.

6. *Be respectful* – No student will be allowed to disrupt the learning process.
7. *Be prepared* – Bring your materials daily. Pick up materials from the "grab-n-go" table, and have your Chromebook fully charged.
8. Use restroom during breaks. You are given **SIX** hall passes per semester. **Unused passes can be turned in for extra credit.**
9. Complete all of your work and turn it in on time.
10. No gum, food or drinks allowed!

1. **Warning:** the teacher provides a verbal reprimand/reminder to student.
2. **Afterschool Detention:** Short time spent afterschool. No exceptions.
3. **Referral:** Student will be sent to the AP, and a written referral will be submitted. Parents will be notified.
4. **Parent conference:** Parents will be asked to have a conference with the teacher, counselor, and the AP.

**LATE / INCOMPLETE WORK**

\* My expectation is that **ALL** assignments be completed to a level of proficiency (**70% or higher**) and turned in on time. Homework is expected **Monday –Thursday**.

\* Parents will be contacted if a student fails to meet proficiency level (**a class grade of 70% or better - a C**)

\* Printer and Internet issues are not an excuse for late work.

\* Late work with no valid excuse will receive half credit or no credit.
