PRIORITY REGISTRATION PROCEDURES FOR 2019-20 LOTTERY: (KINDERGARTEN, 6th and 9th GRADE)

Santa Ana Unified School District is pleased to provide your family registration procedures and informational meetings for incoming Kindergarten, 6th and 9th grade students wishing to attend one of the fundamental schools listed below.

Registration Procedures:

- **Sibling Priority:** Students with siblings currently enrolled at any of the fundamental schools listed below are eligible. **Enrollment Forms should be completed and returned to current school of attendance or directly to the fundamental school of their choice beginning Tuesday, November 5, 2018, through November 13, 2018 at 4:00 p.m.**
- **Eligibility:** New Kindergarten, current 5th and 8th grade students may participate in the lottery.
- **Elementary schools:** You must submit a lottery card to each fundamental school under your consideration.
- **Intermediate and High schools:** Provides a ONE-STOP electronic lottery application when visiting one of the intermediate or high schools listed below. You will be able to apply for all schools under your consideration at once.
- **Lottery Application Dates: Friday, January 11 - Friday, January 25, 2019, office hours are Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.** (Please call for information on extended office hours)
 - Bring the following information:
 - ✓ Name of student's school of residence and student ID number.
- Address verification as evidenced if your student is new to Santa Ana Unified School District.
- **Lottery Results:** Will be posted at each school site, on the school website, and District website on **Wednesday, January 30, 2019.**
- **Selected Lottery Number:** Must have a parent/guardian or an adult (18 years or older) pick up and return enrollment forms beginning **Friday, February 1, 2019 - Thursday, February 14, 2019, no later than 4:00 p.m.** Incomplete packets will not be processed.
