9th Grade

- Take and pass A-G courses with a grade of C or better

10th & 11th Grade

- Take and pass A-G courses with a grade of C or better
- Grades from **10th and 11th** grades are used to determine eligibility

12th Grade

- Take and pass A-G courses with a grade of C or better
- Grades from **10th, 11th, & 12th** grade are used to maintain eligibility
- **CSU will award up to 8 points of AP/IB/Honors credit**

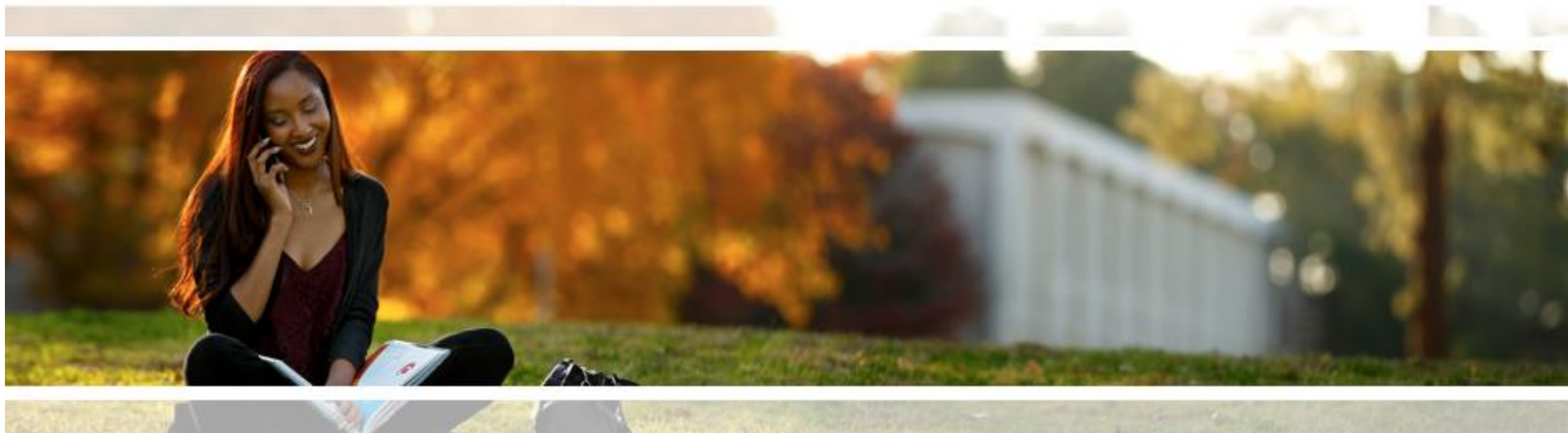
Grades of D or F earned in AP/IB/Honors courses are not given an extra point
