Interdistrict Attendance

The Governing Board recognizes that students who reside in one district may choose to attend school in another district and that such choices are made for a variety of reasons. The Board desires to communicate with parents/guardians and students regarding what educational programs and services are available and how district programs and services may be improved. (cf. 5116.1 - Open Enrollment) (cf. 5117.1 - Interdistrict Attendance Agreements) (cf. 5117.2 - Alternative Interdistrict Attendance Program) (cf. 5145.6 - Notifications Required by Law)

The Governing Board recognizes that current district enrollment corresponds well with district facilities and resources and that the district is capable of serving additional students. Therefore, the Superintendent or designee may approve interdistrict attendance agreements which are in the best interests of the student and are consistent with district needs.
