### Dear SAUSD community,


We just completed all our high school graduation ceremonies at Angel Stadium this past weekend. This was an amazing experience for our students and their families.

### Vaccines for community and staff

New State guidelines now allow for any individual age 12 and older to receive a Covid-19 vaccination. The District continues to offer each weekly Pfizer vaccination clinics through a partnership with <a href="Rite-Aid">Rite-Aid</a>. The District has now provided close to 50,000 vaccines for employees and SAUSD community members through all local partnerships. We are working to secure more vaccination opportunities to ensure all our community members have equitable access.

In the meantime, staff and community members can also secure vaccination appointments as they become available through the Othena app, and through clinics such as those offered through Walmart, Walgreens, CVS, Albertsons, or through their own healthcare provider.
