I GOT MY COVID-19 VACCINE!



Vaccines for community and staff

New State guidelines now allow for any individual age 16 and older to receive a Covid-19 vaccination. The District continues to offer each Monday a Pfizer vaccination clinic at Segerstrom High School, 2301 W MacArthur Blvd., through a partnership with <u>Rite-Aid</u>. Registration information is available by contacting your student's school.

The District has now provided close to 38,000 vaccines for employees and SAUSD community members through all local partnerships. We are working to secure more vaccination opportunities to ensure all our community members have equitable access.

In the meantime, staff and community members can also secure vaccination appointments as they become available through the <u>Othena app</u>, and through clinics such as those offered through <u>Walmart</u>, <u>Walgreens</u>, <u>CVS</u>, <u>Albertsons</u>, or through their own healthcare provider. Discounted internet service provided for qualifying families

Internet connectivity is a vital component for educating our students. Now, the federal government through the Emergency Broadband Benefit will provide a discount of up to \$50 per month toward broadband service for eligible families and households who are struggling to stay connected during the Covid-19 pandemic.
