


Dear SAUSD community,

I am encouraged that our COVID-19 positivity rates for the Santa Ana Unified School District community have remained relatively low following the Thanksgiving break. As you can see in the chart in below, COVID-19 positivity rates are lower across most of our zip codes compared to the county average.

The best way to ensure our rates remain low and even decrease is to continue to improve our vaccination rates across the SAUSD community for all those who are eligible. Research has continuously shown that vaccines are safe and effective in stopping the spread of COVID-19.

SAUSD will continue to host vaccination clinics weekly at many of our campuses with the support of our community partners. Additionally, Latino Health Access will continue to host clinics for all individuals ages 5 and older every Monday from 2:30 to 8 p.m. at 450 W. 4th St., Santa Ana. Public hearing on proposed changes to School Board elections

Please join us tonight, December 6, at 6 p.m. at Segerstrom High School for the final public hearing on a plan to study the process of establishing Trustee Areas and elections By-Trustee Areas that would take effect commencing with the November 2022 election.

By-Trustee Area voting is a method of electing members to the school board in which candidates must reside within a trustee area and the candidates are elected only by the voters residing in that trustee area. SAUSD currently elects its Board of Education members through an at-large election system. Under this system, candidates for the Board of Education can reside anywhere within SAUSD's boundaries.

Where to draw the trustee area boundaries should reflect the needs and interests of the community. Public input will assist the Board of Education in determining which proposed map best suits the needs of the school district.
