DEVELOPMENTAL KINDERGARTEN READING OBJECTIVES



TLW demonstrate an appreciation and enjoyment of reading.
TLW develop an appreciation and enjoyment of reading by: having a language-rich environment within the school and the classroom; making quality literature available through book fairs, book orders, etc.; reading silently; enjoying literature activities; visiting the library often; listening to read alouds; participating in whole or small group discussion.
TLW activate prior knowledge to construct meaning.
TLW understand we read for many purposes: enjoyment, information, directions.
TLW demonstrate progression: left to right page by page
TLW use an illustration to tell a simple one or two sentence story.
TLW recognize various language patterns: rhythm, rhyme, repetition.
TLW recognize various types of reading: poetry, fairy tales, fiction, nonfiction, picture books, songs, and environmental print.
TLW recognize story structure: beginning, middle, end (sequence).
TLW recognize book parts: title, title page, author/illustrator, front/back.
TLW recognize the main idea.
TLW recognize his/her own first name.
TLW recognize the letters in his/her own first name.
TLW sequence four simple illustration cards.
TLW discriminate between letters and numbers.
TLW recognize some letters of the alphabet.
TLW recognize likenesses and differences between pictures and words.
