ROLE OF SCHOOL ADVISORY COMMITTEES

- 1.0 The following regulations will guide local school advisory committees in their efforts to fulfill their roles as defined in BP 1008. These regulations will serve to clarify communication channels for school advisory committee members.
 - 1.1 Any official communication of local school advisory committees directed to the Board of Education (e.g. the school's Educational Master Plan) shall be sent to the Superintendent for distribution to Board members.
 - 1.2 Copies of all official communication shall also be given to:
 - 1.2.1 The building Principal
 - 1.2.2 The appropriate Assistant Superintendent
 - 1.2.3 The Director of Categorical Programs
 - 1.3 In other matters such as inquiry, commendation, expression of a concern, etc., the local School Advisory Committee will first address, in the order given:
 - 1.3.1 Principal and Director of Categorical Programs
 - 1.3.2 Assistant Superintendent (Principal's supervisor)
 - 1.3.3 Superintendent
 - 1.3.4 Board of Education
