Use of School Grounds

1. Use of grounds shared with other governmental entities.
 - a. Outside of school sessions and extracurricular activity hours, certain schools' grounds are booked and controlled by City Parks and Recreation:

Monroe	Godinez Fundamental High School
Greenville	Valley
Spurgeon	Santa Ana High School Tennis Courts
 - b. Parking areas and grounds adjacent to buildings of certain schools are used in the evenings under an annual rental agreement with Santa Ana College:

Godinez Fundamental High School
 - c. The northern portion of Sierra School is under use by the Santa Ana Little League. Little League also uses the following schools for permitted hardball baseball:

Adams	Madison

2. Use of school grounds by other than school personnel, other than those enumerated above, will be scheduled in advance as a community use through the Events Scheduling Department, Santa Ana Unified School District.
3. All schools will have signs posted in visible locations, bearing the following:
 - a. THE SANTA ANA BOARD OF EDUCATION PROHIBITS THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITIES ON SCHOOL PROPERTY:

GOLF PRACTICE	FLYING MODEL PLANES
BICYCLE RIDING	OPERATING GO-CARTS
SKATE BOARDS	ARCHERY PRACTICE
SKATING	OPERATION OF POWERED EQUIPMENT OR VEHICLES
HARDBALL BASEBALL AT ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS	
 - b. Dogs shall not be allowed on school grounds.
