Thank you to all of you for giving our parents and students your time and support. There are several things we are going to work on improving immediately, for example, supervision in the 600 building bathrooms.

I would also like to remind you to keep your grades updated so we can continue to provide our parents with accurate information. Our latest GPA distribution chart shows that about 40% of our students don't have their 2.5 GPA at this point. I do want to add a new dashboard tile which will show what academic interventions you are providing to students, such as before and after school tutoring and going over assignments. This will help us to be in sync with each other and with parents so that we can help to show our students where they need to make an effort. Additionally, please speak with all of your classes and provide them time and opportunity so that they can make up assignments and improve their grades. Sometimes a quick check in once a week or a half period organization time with teacher support might be needed. Let's not forget to take time to help our kids with their executive functioning.



I have great news about our Tools for Teaching class. In addition to 10 Carr teachers who are currently participating in Tools for Teaching, we also have 5 Engage 360 staff. I believe it's more effective for our students to have everyone on the same page. Great job Mandel, Sawyer, Ells, Venturelli, Covey, Supernaw, Rakheja, Hernandez, Tomlinson, MacLean, Guzman, Crystal, Moreno, SanJuana and Bustos!

We also have after school now a Super Snack, which is a hot meal for all of our Engage 360 participants. This program will be extended to include our sports teams as well. Many of our teachers are also providing our students with support after school. Thank you to Ms. Menaldo, Dr. Qafaiti, Mr. Alegre, Ms. Le, Mr. Galvan, Mr. Cervantes, Rakheja, and Supernaw for their participation in math tutoring. For language arts, Ms. Morrell's



reading program and Ms. T and Mrs. Ells's writing program has over 50 students participating. We are holding our students accountable for their work and providing them the support to be able to be successful.

In honor of Red Ribbon Week, we had grade-level drug presentations from Officers Castellanos, Baca and Luevano (pictured below). Thank you for helping the officers to provide this essential information to our students.
