



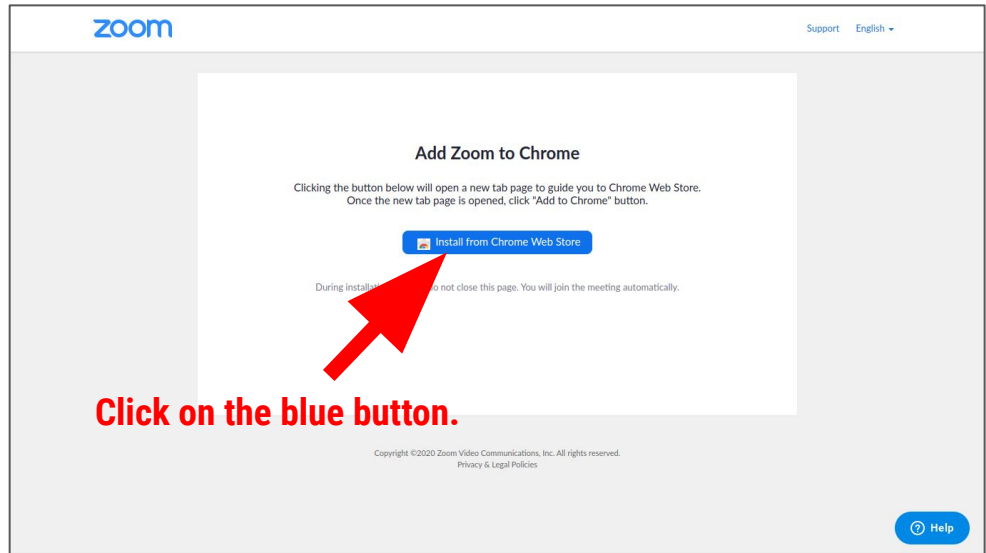
How to make Zoom work on your Chromebooks

STEP #1: Use the link your teacher sends you. Click on the blue button.

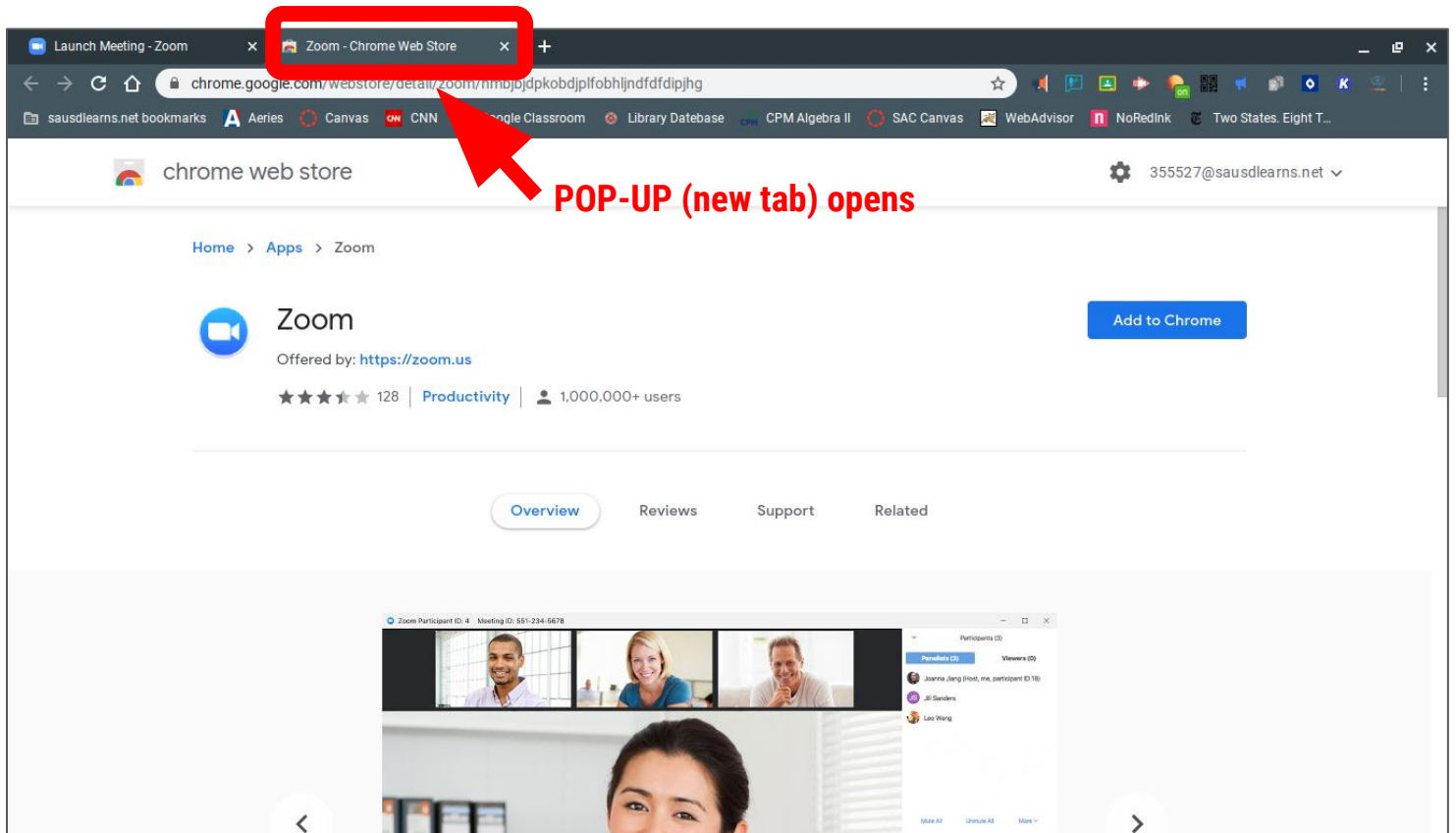
Your teacher will most likely send you a LINK, a 9 digit Session ID, and a 6 digit password.

When you click on the link your teacher sends you via email, you should see this window


You don't need the 9-digit ID, but you will need the 6-digit password later.



STEP #2: A **pop-up** or new tab to the Chrome Web Store will appear asking if you want to “Add Zoom to Chrome.” **Do not install zoom**, as it will not let you install it because of a district firewall.



STEP #3: Go back to the **original tab** and click on the small blue link “Join from your browser” on the bottom right.



STEP #4: Now, you should be able to put in the 6-digit password that your teacher sent you.



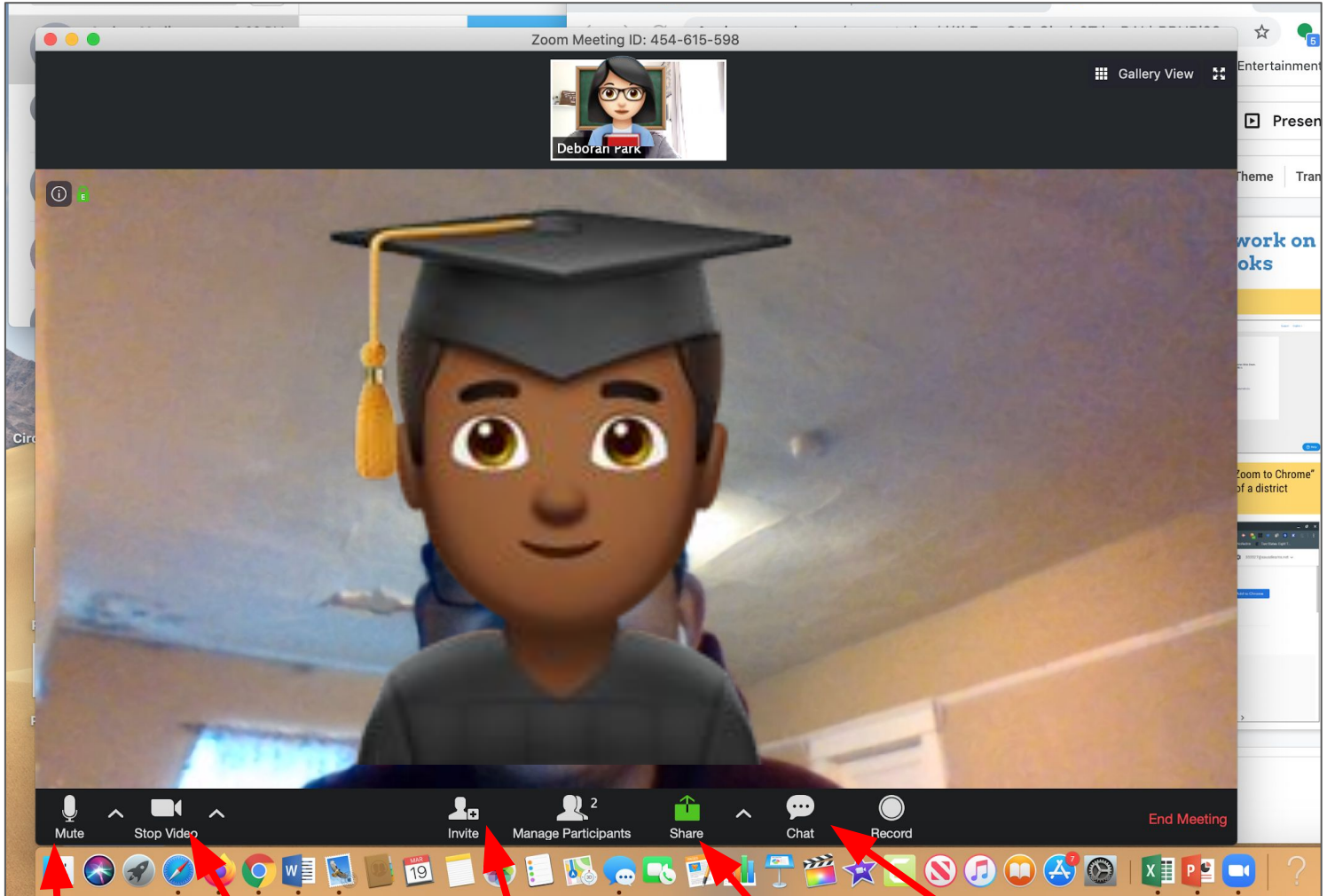
