Dear SAUSD community,

I want to thank you for your support last week as we returned to school following the holiday break. We know there continues to be several challenges. But I want to again reassure everyone that the District is doing everything possible to keep schools open for in-person instruction in the safest possible environment for all our students and staff.

This includes ongoing weekly COVID-19 testing for all our students and staff. Additionally, we continue to secure at-home testing kits for all of our students. We received our initial allotment last week, and expect to receive an additional shipment from the state later this week.

These kits will be sent home with each child as schools receive them. The District will provide more information as it becomes available.
